Heat causes air to expand. That's why the pressure in your tires increases as you drive along. If the pressure is a little low when you take the car out of the garage in the morning, it may come up to normal by the time you have gone a few miles. This is more to be depended upon in summer than in winter.

In Florida, it is recommended to test the tire pressure once a week and be sure that it's up to the specified figure. Five pounds under-inflation in a balloon tire, by test, has been proved to decrease the life of the casing from 25 to 30 per cent.

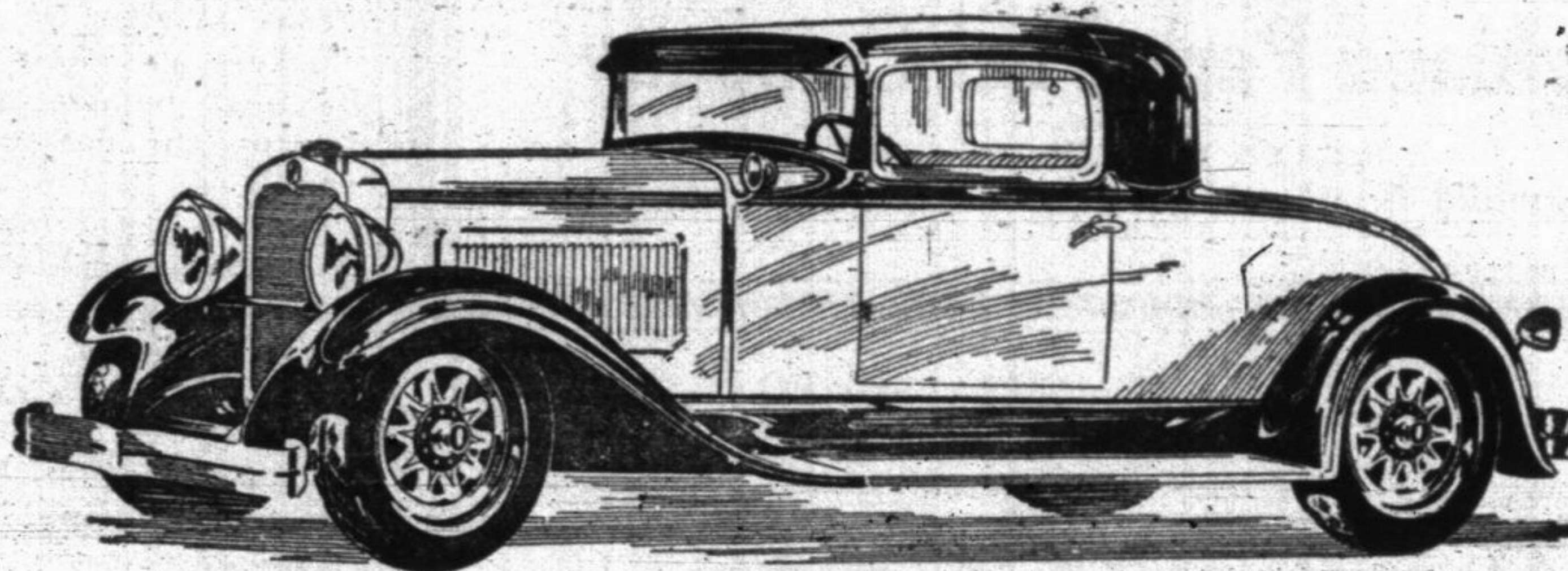
