AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF PARK OFFICERS OF THE HIGH-LAND PARK EAST PARK DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION-ERS OF THE HIGHLAND PARK EAST PARK DISTRICT:.

SECTION 1. That the salaries of the following Park Officers, for the fiscal year beginning June 1st, 1929, and ending May 31st, 1930, be fixed at such sum as is provided for by this Ordinance for such officers for the discharge of the duties of such office, as required under the laws of the State of Illi-


