Illinois League of Women Voters Honored

The Ilinois League of Women Voters was accorded honorable mention in the Get-Out-the-Vote contest conducted by the National League of Women Voters in the presidential campaign, Miss Bertha Bidwell, president of the Illinois League of Woment Voters, announced on her return from the national council meeting. The silver loving cup went to Missouri as the league "which worked most successfully to increase the percentage of the eligible vote cast." Award of the cup was based on the high voting percentage records and ingenuity and careful planning of the league's educational activities to get out the vote. Illinois, among all the states, had the highest per cent of the vote out in the November 1928 election-80.35 per cent.

One member and former president of the Illinois league, Miss Julia Lathrop, is a member of the delegation of twenty-four women who will represent the United States at the International Alliance of Women for Suffrage and Equal Citizenship which meets in Berlin in June.

The National league has taken a stand on the nationality problem which is expected to be an important subject under discussion at the conference on the codification of international law meeting in 1930. It reaffirmed "its belief in the principle, upheld by this organization in its Support of the Cable Act in 732, that the nationality of a married woman should not automatically follow that of her husband but that a married woman should have a voice in the election of her own nationality equal to that accorded to men and to women who are unmarried."

Other recognitions which were given to the Illinois league at the national meeting were in commendation of the democratic financial support of the league whereby each local league does its share and the support comes from a large number of contributors and in commendation of the thorough committee system which carries on the educational work of the league.
