TO INVITE GOVERNOR TO VISIT DUNE LAND

Supervisors Move to Interest Emmerson in Paddock Plan for Big Park

Governor Louis L. Emmerson and Senator Harry Wright, chairman of the senate appropriations committee, are to be invited to make a personal inspection trip of the duneland north of Waukegan along the lake as the guests of the Lake county board of supervisors.

The move to invite the governor and Senator Wright, who is a potential candidate for state treasurer, here was started by the county board last week, after Senator Ray Paddock author of the bill seeking an appropriation of \$5,000,000 for purchase of the "flats" for a state park and game refuge. Representatives Lee McDonough and Richard Lyons, and Mrs. D. M. Courson, president of the Lake County Women Voters' league, spoke before the board members and urged their further co-operation in the project.

Paddock Urges Action

Senator Paddock and Representative McDonough reported that at a recent conference with the governor he declared he was committed to a state park program and indicated he would like to come to Lake county and make a personal inspection of the duneland. Senator Paddock declared that Senator Wright is interested in the state park project and suggested to him that the county board appoint a committee to handle the matter further as regards securing options on the land and inviting the governor to visit the site.

The suggestions of Paddock met instant approval of the board, and, on motion of Supervisor Frank Stanton, Chairman O'Connor was authorized to appoint a committee to cooperate with the state in every way possible to bring about realization

of the project and to invite the governor and Senator Wright to come here.

Chairman O'Connor appointed the same committee that recently made arrangements for the visit of the senate sub-committee here, namely: Frank Stanton, chairman; and Supervisors Obee, Brown, Murphy, and Thompson.

Urge States to Adopt Grade Crossing Plans

A definite recommendation that each state adopt a program for installing safety warning devices of a standardize type at railroad grade crossings, has recently been made by the United States Bureau of Public Roads as Washington. While the motorists have been talking about this problem for many years, the officials of the Government have been studying the problem and they have set about to secure the co-operation of state officials to prevent the continued slaughter of human life that has been going on since the first "benzine-buggy" was invented.

Refrigeration Helps Wider Truck Gardening

The Eastern half of the United States is rapidly increasing its production of fruits and vegetables, according to Government statistics. This is traceable to highway improvement and motor truck transportation which makes it possible for many Eastern farmers to grow some products which were out of the question when these farmers were dependent upon wagon transportation. Prior to the development of refrigeration, practically all fresh fruit and vegetable production was in the immediate vicinity of the large cities.
