

Lake County Third in Illinois Sales of Autos in May

Lake county stands third in the list of automobile sales in Illinois during the month of May, according to a report made public recently by the Illinois chamber of commerce.

The records show that a total of 609 automobiles were sold in Lake county during the month of May of which 209 were made through Waukegan automobile firms.

The two counties which reported more sales of automobiles in that month than Lake county are Cook with 14,272 sold, and Winnebago with

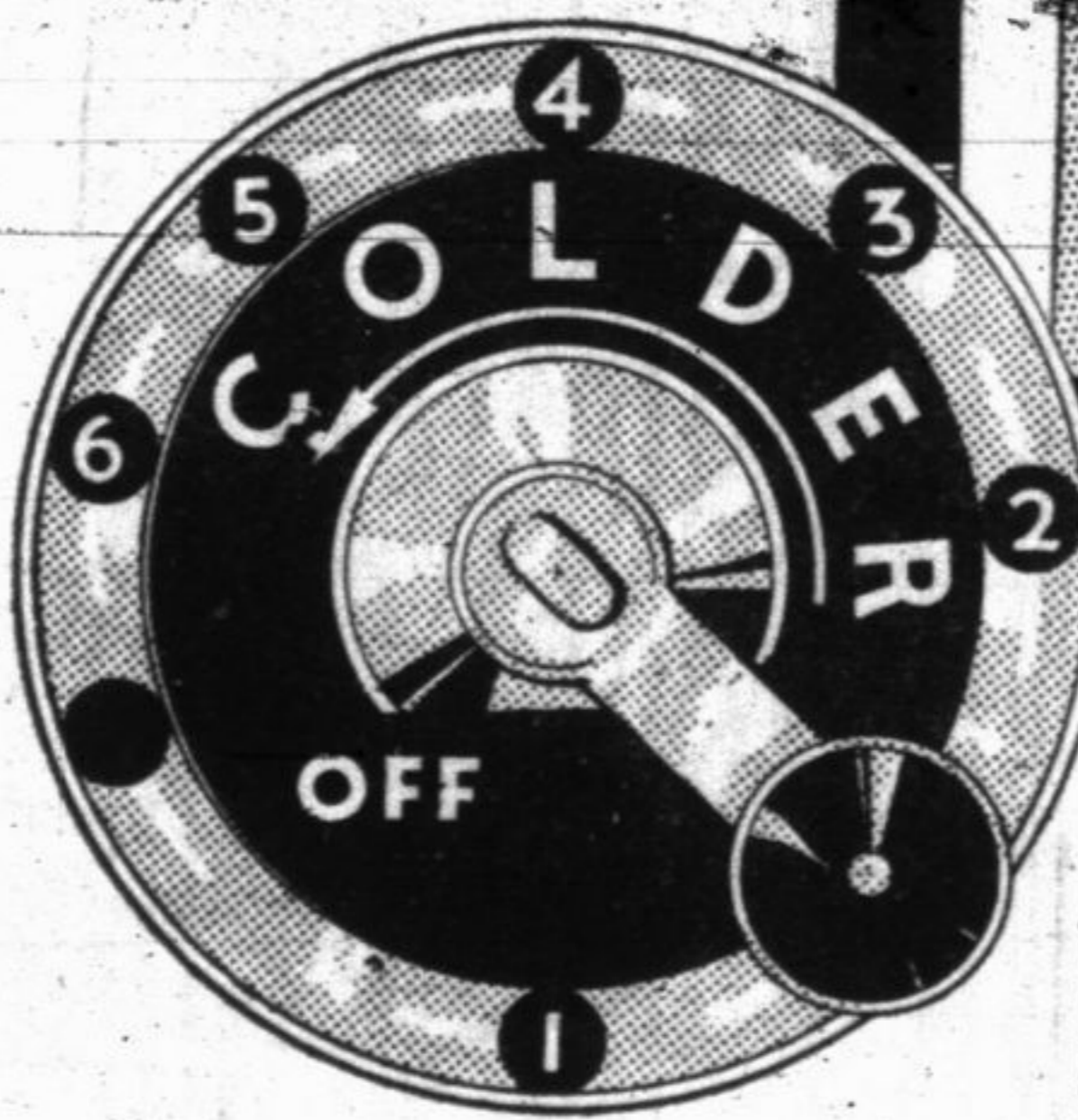
709 were retailed during the period. Sales of automobiles for the month in the state fell somewhat below that of April. Sales for May in the state totaled 28,774 while for the month of April they totaled 29,725. The sales of cars in the state since the first of the year totaling 114,193 is believed to establish a record for similar periods.

occasion Henri Rabaud's fantastic ultra-modern opera "Marouf" will be the offering, a fact that will be particularly gratifying to Ravinia patrons in view of the immense success achieved by this opera when it was given last season as a novelty. Mme. Yvonne Gall and Bario Chamlee will again have the principal roles, the former appearing as the Princess while the latter will be heard in the name part. Before coming to Ravinia Mme. Gall had sung the prima donna role of this opera in Paris under the direction of the composer. Last season the title role was new to Mr. Chamlee, but in it he achieved such success that he was called to Paris this spring where as Marouf, he won the laudation of critics and public. Others who will have fine parts in this opera are Mme. Julia Claussen, Jose Mojica, Leon Rothier, George Cehanovsky, Vittorio Trevisan, Louis D'Angelo, Giordano Paltrinieri, Paolo Ananian, Ruth Page, Edwin Strawbridge and ballet. Louis Hasselmans will conduct.

The Sunday afternoon concerts which have always been a special feature of every Ravinia season will be given again this year and Mr. Eckstein announces that for the most part they will consist of programs of national music, thus serving to present the most representative music of the world. The concert arranged for Sunday afternoon, June 23, will be American in tone, the program to be presented by the Chicago Symphony orchestra consisting of works by such American composers as Hadley, Chadwick, Borowski, Deems Taylor and Frederic Stock. Alfred Wallenstein, cellist, will be the soloist, his group being of European origin and including numbers by Bach, Haydn and Boccherini. Eric DeLamarter will conduct.

Monday Night

On Monday night, June 24, the Chicago Symphony orchestra will again be heard, this time in a concert of symphonic proportions as Mr. DeLamarter has selected as his principal offering on this occasion Tchaikowsky's Symphony No. 5 in E minor. The soloists will be Jacques Gordon, violinist, and Joseph Vito, harpist. Mr. Gordon is to play Mendelssohn's Concerto for violin while Mr. Vito will be heard in Dubois' "Fantasie" for harp and orchestra. There is no charge for reserved seats at either the Sunday afternoon or the Monday night concerts, the general admission at the gate covering everything.

Tuesday Night

This year the performance of Tuesday night, June 25 takes on special importance for this event will mark Ravinia's anniversary and in celebration of it Mr. Eckstein has scheduled Charpentier's "Louise" in which Mme. Gall will have the name part and Edward Johnson will make his debut of the current season as Julien. It was in this famous French work that Mme. Gall was first heard at Ravinia two seasons ago, and at that time Mr. Johnson scored a tremendous success as the young artist. Julian Claussen will be heard as the mother and Leon Rothier will have the important part of the father. Others in the cast are Jose Mojica, Gladys
