**Interesting Happenings About

Selection of the name of the branch post office to be located at Edison court, Waukegan, is to be deferred by the committee until it is decided beyond question as to where the office will be located.

Institution of merchant police at the solution of the policing problem in Waukegan is being urged by local authorities in an effort to give the city better police protection with the present police force.

After the Government had for some time paid the county on the basis of 85 cents per day for the keep of a federal prisoner, Sheriff Lawrence Doolittle recently was informed that the old rate of 65 cents a prisoner had been adopted again by the government and the increase would not be granted.

The bill of Rep. R. J. Lyons of Mundelein, prohibiting motorboat motors to be used without mufflers, was approved in the state senate and probably will be signed by Gov. Louis L. Emmerson.

Joseph Garreson and Frank Poff, both residents of Fox Lake, last week started terms on one year each in the Wisconsin state prison on a charge of stealing automobile tires, according to the Waukegan Sun. They had been charged with taking the tires at Lake Geneva and were tried at Elkhorn, Wis.

Resignation of J. A. Sessions as general secretary of the Waukegan Y. M. C. A. and his acceptance of a responsible position in the general offices of the Y. M. C. A. in Chicago was announced last week-end following a meeting of the board of directors.

After emerging from a condition near death in which he remained for hours, John Daley, state highway policeman who received serious injuries when his motorcycle was struck by a motor truck, last week, was reported as much improved and indications are that he will recover.
