**Chicago Fireman Named  
New Lake Forest Chief**

Appointment of Captain James Hough, 42 years old, a member of the Chicago fire department for 22 years until his retirement following an accident 15 months ago, as the first regular full time fire chief of Lake Forest, was confirmed by the Lake Forest village board last week. The recommendation was made by Mayor A. B. Dick, Jr. Captain Hough will begin his new duties July 1.

Heretofore the Lake Forest fire department has been headed by volunteer chiefs. William J. O'Neill was chief from 1895 to 1927, when he was succeeded by his son, William J. O'Neill, Jr. The board voted to present Mr. O'Neill with a gold star in recognition of his past services.

It is the plan of the council to have the new chief make a survey of the city and suggest improvements.

**Seine Carp Out of  
Druce and Third Lake**

At Druces grove on Third Lake and Sunday at Pratts on Druces Lake, the commercial fisherman that the Walton league had contracted with to seine these lakes hauled in their long line of nets and a big haul of carp, dogfish and gars was the result. This cleaning out of these coarse fish, that are destroyers of all game fish, will result in some very much improved fishing in these waters.

The seining was done under the supervision of the State Conservation department and all other fish will be returned to the water unharmed. Game Warden Henry Kern assisted by deputies will represent the state.
