**Conservation Project  
 in McHenry and Lake  
 Counties Is Delayed**

Petition for a conservancy district, covering approximately fifty square miles, including the chain of lakes from the Wisconsin line south through Antioch in Lake county and Johnsburg in McHenry county, was delayed again last week in county court by Attorney George F. Hurley, who is acting for petitioners, because plans for the Nippersink dam have not been unfolded.

The state has appropriated \$25,000 for an engineering survey near McHenry to provide a dam. The next assembly is to provide further appropriations, it is understood. This engineering, the attorney stated, would have an effect on water levels in the proposed conservancy district.

Residents in that vicinity are eager to end the pollution of lakes and streams where more than 10,000 people are making their homes during the summer months.

Mr. Hurley stated that it probably would cost the municipalities and the communities in the district close to \$1,000,000 over a period of several years of construction to purify the waters of the lake regions.

J. M. Halverson was made collector and Fire Chief Kreck was re-appointed. Halverson succeeded J. H. Franzen.

Fox Lake has been torn by dissension for the past few months and an effort to get the members of the board and residents in harmony to carry out municipal improvements is being made, according to the Waukegan Sun.
