### Find Body of Child Drowned in Channel Lake After 50 Hours

After dragging the bottom of Channel lake for more than 50 hours, Capt. O. W. Fricke and Surfman G. O. Magnusson of the U. S. Coast Guard station at Evanston, Wednesday night of last week, recovered the body of the little 2-year-old Dorothy English, who was drowned the previous Monday afternoon when she slipped from the seat of a boat where she was riding beside her mother.

According to the coast guardsmen, the tiny body was wedged in the mud in the bottom of the lake under about 25 feet of water.

Don English, father of the child, who had been on duty constantly since the drowning, is an official of the Evanston Auto Parts company and conducts a branch plant on South Genesee street in Waukegan.

### Motor Cop Calls Sick Bluff of Auto Speeder

Something new in the way of an alibi, and the usual skepticism of a motor-cop, was brought to light today when reports from the Lake County General hospital showed that a speeder had pleaded that he was rushing to a hospital as a method of convincing a cop he had the right to travel 65 miles an hour.

The man, Morris Sanisla, of 171 Buffalo street, Milwaukee, was going 65 miles an hour on Green Bay road near Zion when a motor-cop drew alongside and inquired for reasons for the rush.

The motorist explained that he was taking a man to the hospital, and the cop, inclined to believe the story, offered a suggestion.

"The nearest hospital is just seven miles away. We'll go there," he said.

Dr. Karl Beck, county physician, examined the "patient" and found nothing wrong.

"Well, we'll be going before the judge," the cop said as he took his prisoner away.

### To Deport Two Mexican Residents of Waukegan

Juan Cervantes, 515 Market street, and Mrs. Sirillia Castilio of the same address, were taken from the county jail last week and turned over to Inspector F. Davis of the United States Department of Labor for deportation to Mexico. Both have been in the county jail awaiting deportation action for the past two weeks.

The two Mexicans are charged with coming in to the United States without passports and without having gone through the legal formality required by law.
