New Registration Law May not Be Applicable in Lake County, Report

The central registration law, which was passed by the general assembly a short time ago to allow those whose occupation prevent them from placing their names on the poll books on specified days to register at the offices of election commissioners in various counties of the state, is still not definitely defined as far as Lake county is concerned.

At the office of County Clerk Lew Hendee it was said that it is believed the law will not materially affect voters here because there is no board of commissioners handling elections, the registrations being taken care of solely by precinct boards. The law is in effect today.

The law was designed to accommodate commercial travelers, railroad men, and others whose occupation prevents their registration on specified days. The law permits such persons to register at the office of the board of election commissioners at any time prior to the compilation of the registration lists for each election. It also provides that registered voters may be transferred from precincts in which they formerly resided to new precincts by making application for transfer at the office of the election commissioners.
