Carl Buhl of Laurel avenue is leaving Friday for Au Gres, Michigan, for a two weeks visit at the Edwin Simms Ranch.

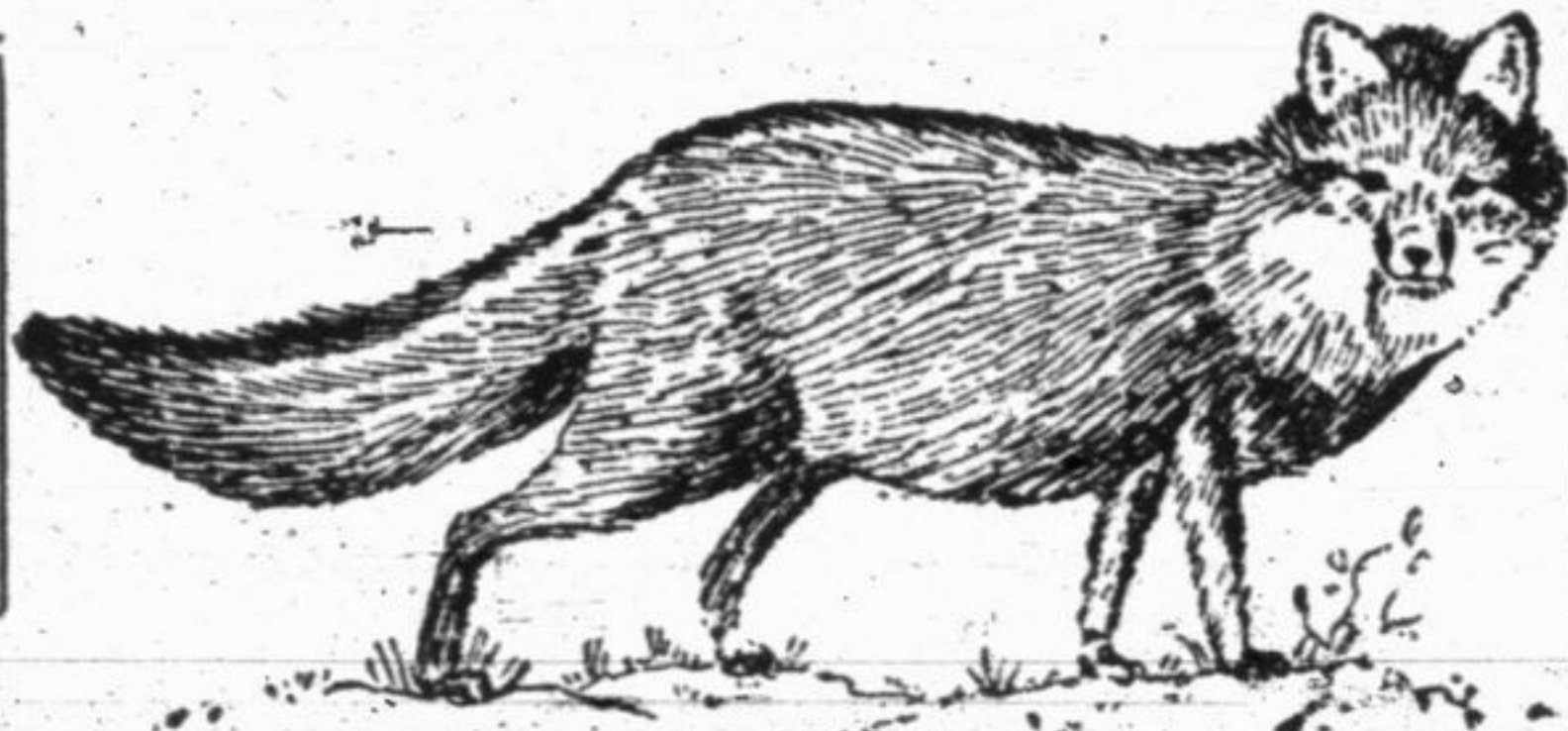
