
It's a slap at a man's credit when his check comes back marked N.S.F. (Not Sufficient Funds.) It means that he has written a check for more money than he has on deposit in the bank.

Is it fair to blame your banker if your check is returned marked N.S.F.? You have asked him to illegally pay your bills with your neighbor's money. Remember that the money at the bank is not the banker's money but that of his depositors. . . . the people of the neighborhood. A banker's first duty is to his depositors. They have entrusted their money to him for safekeeping. He must be prepared to give it back to them when they ask for it.

Avoid the annoyance of returned checks and protest fees. Safeguard your credit by carrying a sufficient balance to take care of all checks you write.
