### STUDENT ROOKIES ARE LEARNING FAST

Show Snap in Drill and Rapidly Adapt Themselves to Military Duties

With only one week's training to their credit, 2,000 youngsters at Fort Sheridan went through drill maneuvers last Thursday with the snap and precision of regulars.

They are members of the seventh annual Citizens' Military Training camp, who massed at Camp Deiley last Thursday for a month of peacetime war training.

Majority "Raw"

More than half the group are recruits with no previous military experience. The remainder are second, third and fourth-year men, of whom many of the latter hope to qualify for commissions in the regular army reserve at the duration of camp.

The second of the semi-weekly cadet dances was held in the post gymnasium last night. Two hundred girls, from north shore villages, chaperoned by members of women's organizations, danced with 500 youngsters.

With the installation of large full-length mirrors at strategic points in the company streets yesterday, rookies employing the worn-out alibi of having no mirror will be without an excuse when disciplined for careless appearance.

Must Reflect 'Em

Instructions have been posted to use the glasses before every formation where complete dress is re-

quired. While most officers are careful of personal appearance, a somewhat smaller mirror has been placed in such a way that they also must pass it when leaving officer streets. Its proximity to the mess hall insures constant use.

Great effort is being made to have the troops in such condition that the first general review, which will take place Saturday, will be handled efficiently. Governor Emmerson, Representative Roy Chindblom, Senator Charles S. Deneen and other civil and military officials are expected. Wisconsin and Michigan days will occur on the following two Saturdays, when representatives of those two states will also review the young soldiers.
