#### CULINARY HINTS

During the summer months we usually like cold desserts best, and I have found a Red Raspberry Torte attractive as well as appetizing.

Red Raspberry Torte

1 egg 4 cup sugar -

1/8 teaspoon salt cup milk

½ teaspoon vanilla 2 tablespoons gelatine

1/4 cup cold water

½ pint whipping cream 1 box red raspberries

½ cup raspberry juice

2 tablespoons sugar teaspoon gelatine

1 tablespoon cold water

Scald milk, add egg beaten with sugar and cook two or three minutes, add salt and vanilla, also gelatine which has been soaked five minutes in the 4 cup of cold water, stirring until dissolved. When chilled and partly thickened, fold in the cream whipped thick.

Place the above mixture in a cold baked pie shell and set in ice box. Pick over and wash berries, drain well and save enough of the best to cover the custard in the pie shell. Add a little water to the remaining berries, cook until soft and put through sieve to remove seeds. There juice to make the ½ cup of raspberry juice.

Add the 2 tablespoons of sugar to the juice, also 1 teaspoon gelatine soaked five minutes in the one tablespoon cold water. Set in ice box to chill, pour over berries while still liquid and chill until it forms a glazed top to the torte.

### Geology Expedition from Northwestern U. Leaves for Canada-U. S. Border

Canoes and camping sites along the boundary between the United States and Canada will constitute the class rooms of Prof. U. S. Grant and Prof. J. T. Stark of the department of geology and geography of Northwestern university for four weeks this summer when they take a party of twenty students on an all-canoe geological field trip in the Lake Superior

Leaving Evanston on August 12, the party will go first to Ely, Minn. After outfitting there, the canoeing geologists will paddle westward along the international boundary between Minnesota and Ontario and circle back to Ely.

The purpose of the trip, the only one of its kind, will be to study the Pre-Cambrian geology of parts of the Lake Superior region, especially northeastern Minnesota and adjacent parts of Ontario. The students will be trained in methods of geological field work and in detailed mapping of selected areas.


