His image or idea, is governed by Him—by His law. It is to deny that there is other law or power to interfere with or to prevent the full and perfect enforcement of God's law. It is the prayerful effort to bring one's concept of life into accord with the Word of God. Paul says, "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever, therefore, resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation." Christian Science is therefore taking for man a logical position as governed by God who is the only power. It recognizes that whosoever resists God's law, does so at his peril. Christian Science affirms the perfection of being and denies the reality of disease, pain and suffering because of the fact that God is Love, and therefore unable and unwilling to afflict His children. If God does not afflict, then the so-called disease or affliction is unreal because "there is no power but of God."

**Conclusion**

Christian Science when properly understood, offers a broad and sure foundation on which any sincere seeker after Truth may find rest, peace and salvation. It voices the cry of the prophet, "Look unto me, and be ye saved all the ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is none else." **Chicken Cutlets**  
 (using leftovers)  
 2 cups chopped cooked chicken, 2 tbs. each chopped carrots and green pepper, 1 tsp. salt, ½ tsp. pepper, 1 tsp. minced parsley, ½ tsp. onion juice, 1 tbs. lemon juice. To 1 cup white sauce add these ingredients and cook 3 minutes. Add 2 eggs well beaten. Remove from fire, cool and shape into cutlets; dip in egg and crumbs and fry in deep fat.

**Pineapple Nut Salad in Tomatoes**  
 Mix 1 cup shredded pineapple with 1 cup chopped nuts and blend with French dressing. Put on ice. Peel and scoop out top of tomatoes; fill with pineapple nut mixture; garnish with mayonnaise and serve very cold.

**Boston Bean Sandwiches**  
 Press ½ cupful of beans through potato ricer; season with 1 tbs. horseradish, 1 tsp. celery, 1 tsp. parsley, both minced fine, ½ tsp. onion juice, ½ tsp. mustard, dash of Tabasco or Worcestershire sauce. Spread between slices of wholewheat bread; add crisp lettuce leaf.

**Oil and Gas Distributors Register at Springfield**

Seven hundred and one oil distributors now are registered and collecting from filling stations three cents for every gallon of motor gasoline sold to them. This number is registered with the state finance department and more are expected to register soon.
