Good advice is sometimes negative—so, unless you really are an expert, don't monkey with your carburetor. If it goes wrong, have a mechanic look at it. But before blaming it for the trouble, examine your spark plugs, distributor points, battery terminals and gas line for dirt or disorder.

When you suddenly find yourself rushing to a bad hole in the road, don't jam on your brakes—unless you have time to reduce your speed and release the brakes before you hit the hole. If you take it at high speed with the brakes on, the result may be a broken spring.

Said ordinance provides, and notice is hereby given, that the Council may, by a majority vote, reject any and all bids and it may adjourn consideration of said bids to the next regular meeting of said Council.

The said ordinance also provides that, in the event of the acceptance by the Council of a bid or bids for said property, the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the Purchaser a quitclaim deed under the seal of the City of Highland Park, conveying the property hereinabove described.
