**N. S. LINE OPENING
AIR-RAIL ROUTES**

Inaugurates This Service to St.
Louis, Cleveland and Kan-
sas City Aug. 26

Travel time between north shore
communities and St. Louis, Cleveland
and Kansas City is cut by a new rail-
air service inaugurated by the Chi-
cago North Shore and Milwaukee
railroad (North Shore Line) and the
Universal Air Lines System tomor-
row (Monday, August 26), it is an-
nounced by R. S. Amis, general pas-
senger agent of the "Road of Ser-
vice."

The service embraced in the North
Shore Line-Universal Air Lines hook-
up also embraces through transporta-
tion to New York, Boston, Los An-
geles, San Diego, Denver, Wichita,
Tulsa, Omaha and many other cities
served by interconnections with steam
railroads and auxiliary air routes.
Included among these routes is the
transcontinental service recently es-
tablished by the Universal Air Lines
with the New York Central and the
Santa Fe.

Additional Service
This additional service supplements
the rail-air schedule to Detroit and
other eastern points recently inaugu-
rated by the North Shore Line in
conjunction with the Stout Air Lines.
The facilities offered by these two
hook-ups enable residents of Milwau-
kee, Racine, Kenosha, Waukegan and
other cities north of Chicago to save
many hours in traveling to points
east, south and west.

Persons traveling to points served
by this new rail-air schedule will
board high-speed all-steel limiteds on
the North Shore Line, proceeding to
Chicago over the Skokie Valley route.
They will transfer in downtown Chi-
cago to special motor coaches which
will whisk them to the Municipal Air-
port. There they will immediately
board the luxurious tri-motored Fok-
ker planes of the Universal Air Lines
for the flight to their destination.
These planes, accommodating 14 pas-
sengers each, are equipped with all
the latest devices for the comfort and
convenience of passengers en route.

Saves Time
The travel time from Milwaukee to
Cleveland by this new route is only
5 hours and 45 minutes, to St. Louis
5 hours and 40 minutes and to Kan-
sas City only 7 hours and 50 minutes.
Corresponding reductions are made in
the travel time from Racine, Kenosha,
Waukegan and other north shore cit-
ies.

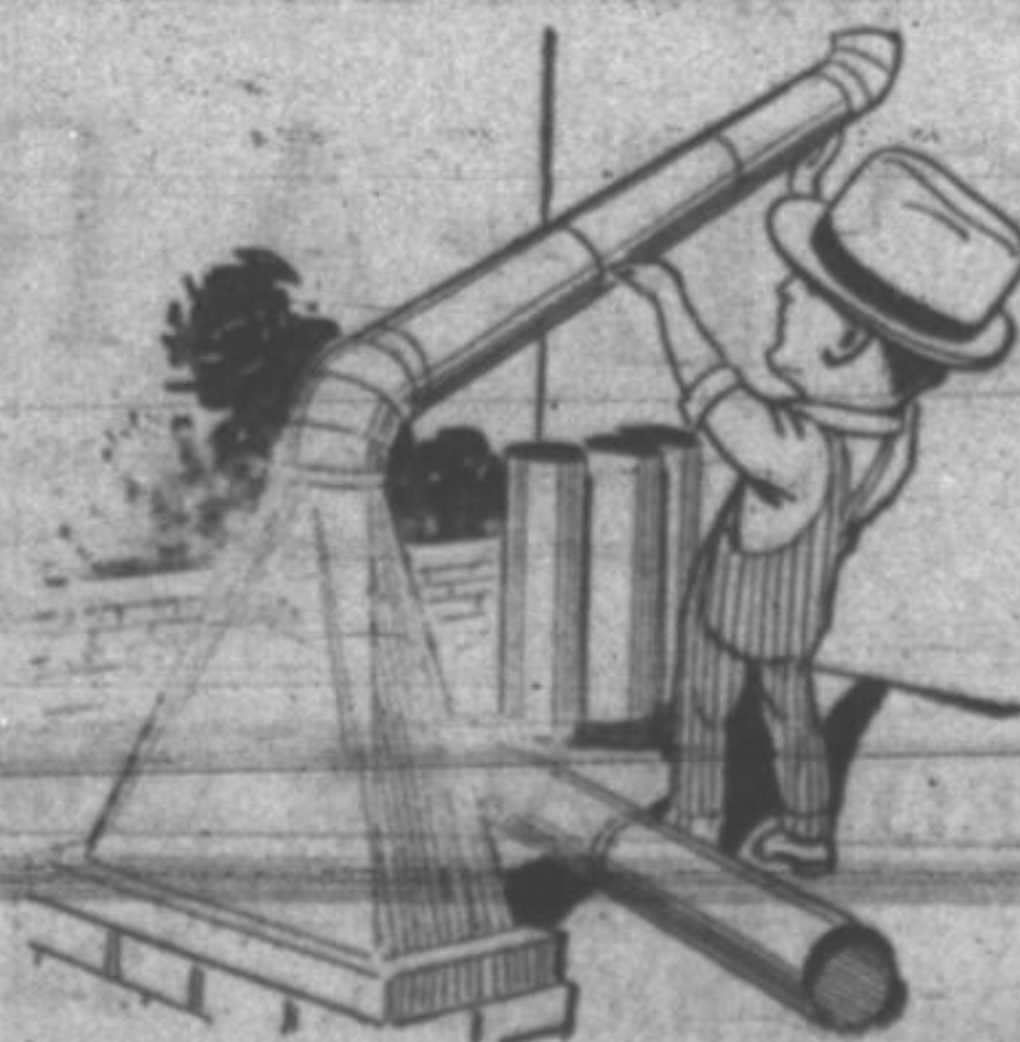
