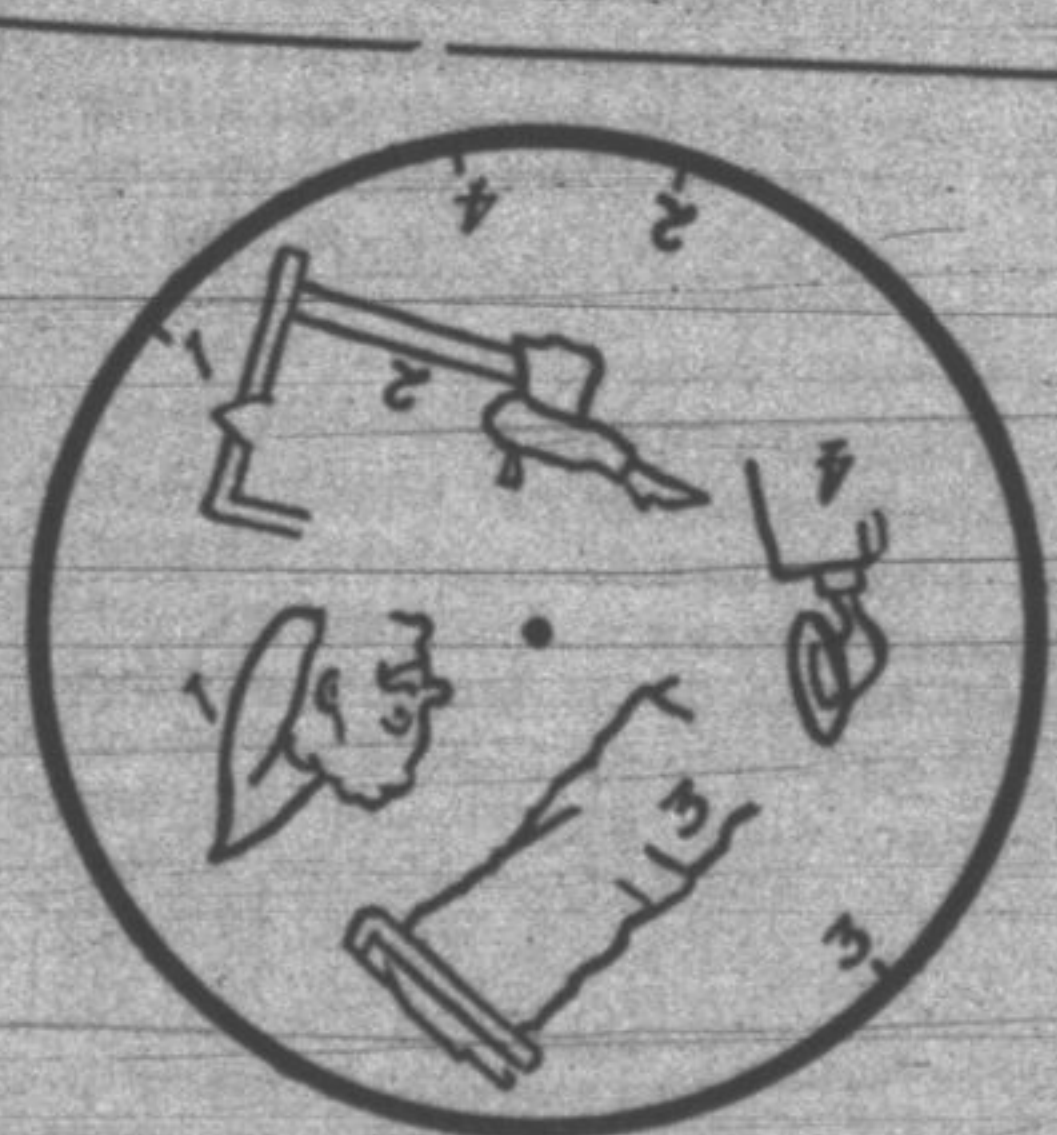

Last Mexican War Survivor Is Dead

Taps have sounded for America's last survivor of the Mexican war, Owen Thomas Edgar of Washington, who became the lone veteran of the war of 1846 last June, the day before his ninety-eighth birthday, is dead. Death, which came last week was attributed directly to shock incident to a broken leg sustained in a fall about a week ago at the John Dickson home where he has lived for nearly ten years. He was born at Philadelphia and was a printer until his enlistment as a seaman. He served on the frigates Potomas and Allegheny.

Burial will be at the Congressional cemetery, Thursday afternoon, beside the grave of his wife, who preceded him in death twenty years ago. He is survived by a daughter, a resident of Washington.

That said City of Highland Park now offers for sale the said property hereinabove described to the highest and best bidder.

That said property is a parcel of land now owned by the City and now vacant.

Bids on the sale of said property will be received and considered by the Council of said City of Highland Park at a regular meeting to be held in the City Hall in the City of Highland Park, Lake County, Illinois, on Monday, the 30th day of September, 1929, at 7:45 o'clock P. M., at which time the bids will be opened and considered. All bids shall be made for cash, possession to be delivered upon payment of the purchase price, and shall be accompanied by a certified check for \$2000.00. All bids shall be sealed and deposited with the City Clerk for presentation to the Council at said meeting.

Said ordinance provides, and notice is hereby given, that the Council may, by a majority vote, reject any and all bids and it may adjourn consideration of said bids to the next regular meeting of said Council.

The said ordinance also provides that, in the event of the acceptance by the Council, of a bid or bids for said property, the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the Purchaser a quit-claim deed under the seal of the City of Highland Park, conveying the property hereinabove described.

Said ordinance so passed on Monday, August 26, 1929, is on file in the office of the City Clerk in the City Hall at Highland Park and is open to public inspection.
