Aviator Is Added to Staff of Sheriff of Lake Co.; His Duties

Sheriff Lawrence Doolittle last week added an aviator to his personal staff of deputies and in the future is to take advantage of anything aviation can add to the apprehension of criminals or carrying out the routine of his office.

Vernon Ramsey, head of the Mc-Millan-Ramsey Flying Service, located at Waukegan airport, was deputized to complete the dream of the sheriff, who for two years has wanted to place an aviator on his staff.

Ramsey aided the sheriff in locating the five drowning victims at Long Lake recently and ever since then Doolittle has been of the opinion that an airplane could be of real value to the office.

While Ramsey failed in his attempt to locate the bodies it was due to the fact that motor boats, towing drag nets and grappling hooks, had stirred up the mud so that he could not see the bottom of the lake. He had been able to see the bottom of the other lakes he crossed going out there.
