

### Lake Bluff Planning Many Improvements in New Subdivisions

Application has been made by the village of Lake Bluff for confirmation of several special assessments consisting of paving, sidewalks, sewers and water mains in new subdivisions. A list of these improvements follow:  
Water main, service connections, etc., in the Stone subdivision west of the North Western tracks. Also for a sewer in the same property.

Water main in Sheridan road and other streets of the village.

Connected system of sewers in Oak Terrace and Sunset place in the south subdivision.

Tile pipe storm water sewer in Sunset place from the east end of Sheridan road to the east line of Idle Hour subdivision.

Paving of Oak Terrace from Sheridan road to Witchwood lane including the intersection of Hawthorne court and Ravine Forest drive.

Cement sidewalk, five feet wide,

along both sides of Sunset place from Sheridan road to the east end of Sunset place.

Hearing upon the above improvements will occur in County court on September 23 at 10 a. m.

### Lathers Get Increase in Wages Is Reported

An increase in wages of 60 cents a day and a five day week has been granted to lathers of Waukegan and other towns on the north shore in which these workers are affiliated

with the Chicago local of that union through agreement signed Tuesday.

The agreement is retroactive to September 1. The new wage schedule of working days will hold good until May 31, 1932, according to Waukegan papers.

The most important provision in the agreement, according to labor leaders, is the granting of the shorter work week to another of the building trades.

The new wage scale of the lathers, with the increase, is \$13.60 a day, the same as was granted to the plasterers.
