

Charge Three Soldiers With Robbery of Stand; Lodged in County Jail

Privates Marvin J. Vreeland, 22, and Andrew Calvetti, 20, members of Troop A. Fourteenth Cavalry, at Fort Sheridan were in the county jail last Thursday as the armed bandits who on the previous Friday night robbed the Chicken-Hot Dog luncheon on Green Bay road near Belvidere road and the Dahlia Gardens on Green Bay road near Yorkhouse corners. iff Lawrence Doolittle are written confessions signed by the pair which clear up the highway thefts and also others at Fort Sheridan. The confessions were made to Capt. George Heckinger and Deputy Harry Qusndt following the arrest of the two at Fort Sheridan. Lieut. Robert D. Reed, investigating officer at the fort, played an important part in the arrest of the robbers and in obtaining of the confessions. His work won great praise from Sheriff Doolittle and the deputies.

Car Stolen by Robbers
The Peerless touring car which the

robbers used in their work Friday evening was stolen from a street one block east of Green Bay road in Highland Park and near the Chrysler Sales company. It is the property of Alex Rafferty of Highland Park.

Boasts made to companions at Fort Sheridan proved the undoing of Vreeland and Calvetti. The roll obtained in the hold-ups was flashed and the thrills of the experience were recounted until finally the commander of the guard ordered their arrest. The sheriff's office was notified and the confessions followed.

Mutual Insurance Holders Are Taxed When Concern Fails

A large number of Lake county automobile owners who had their cars insured in the Federal Automobile Insurance association during the years 1924 to 1927 inclusive, last week received notices from attorneys for the receivers of the company that their assessment amounted to the total amount of their premiums for the four years the company existed, says the Waukegan Sun, which continues:

One local man, insured in the company during the entire four years, was assessed \$171, while others were assessed in varying amounts in smaller and even larger sums.

In 1927 the company notified the policy holders that the company had failed and that their policies were non-existent. A receiver was appointed and proceedings were started in the circuit court at Edwardsville, Ill., where the law office of Geers and Geers was appointed counsel for the receiver.

The insurance association was a mutual and reciprocal organization and the failure of the company effected the policy holders to the full extent of their premiums.

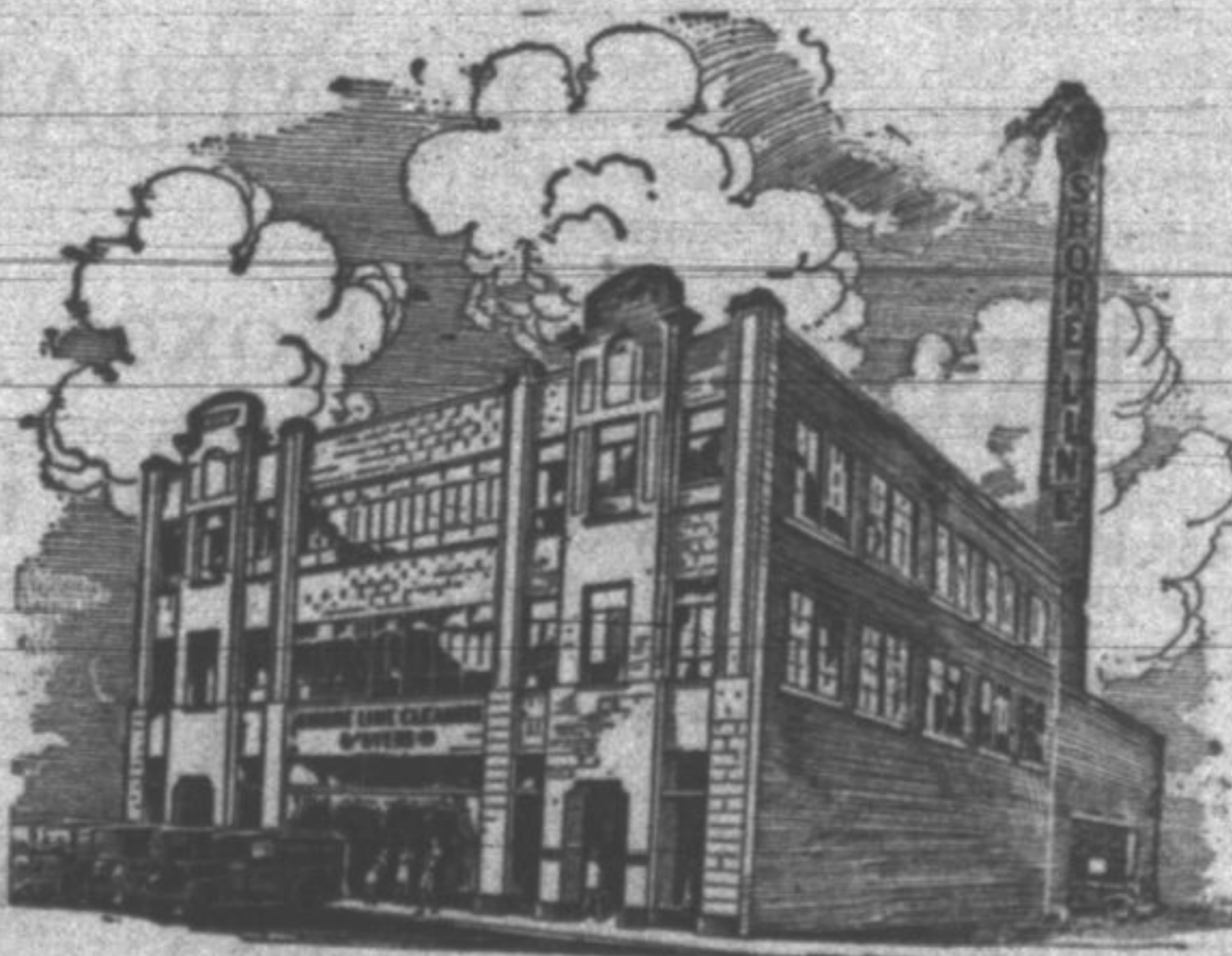
Notice of the assessments included the statement that unless payment of the full amount was made by Sept. 28, 1929, the receiver's attorneys would start suit to get judgments against the former policy holders for the full amount.
