### Arrested on Charge of Stabbing Fellow Worker

Fred Directo, a Filipino employed  
at the Exmoor club was arrested Sat-  
urday night following a fight with  
Albert Bystrum, another employe, in  
which it is reported to the po-  
lice, Directo had stabbed Bystrum  
in the arm and chest with a pen knife.  
The injured man's wounds were  
dressed at the hospital and he was  
sent home. The injuries were not
