Lincoln Park

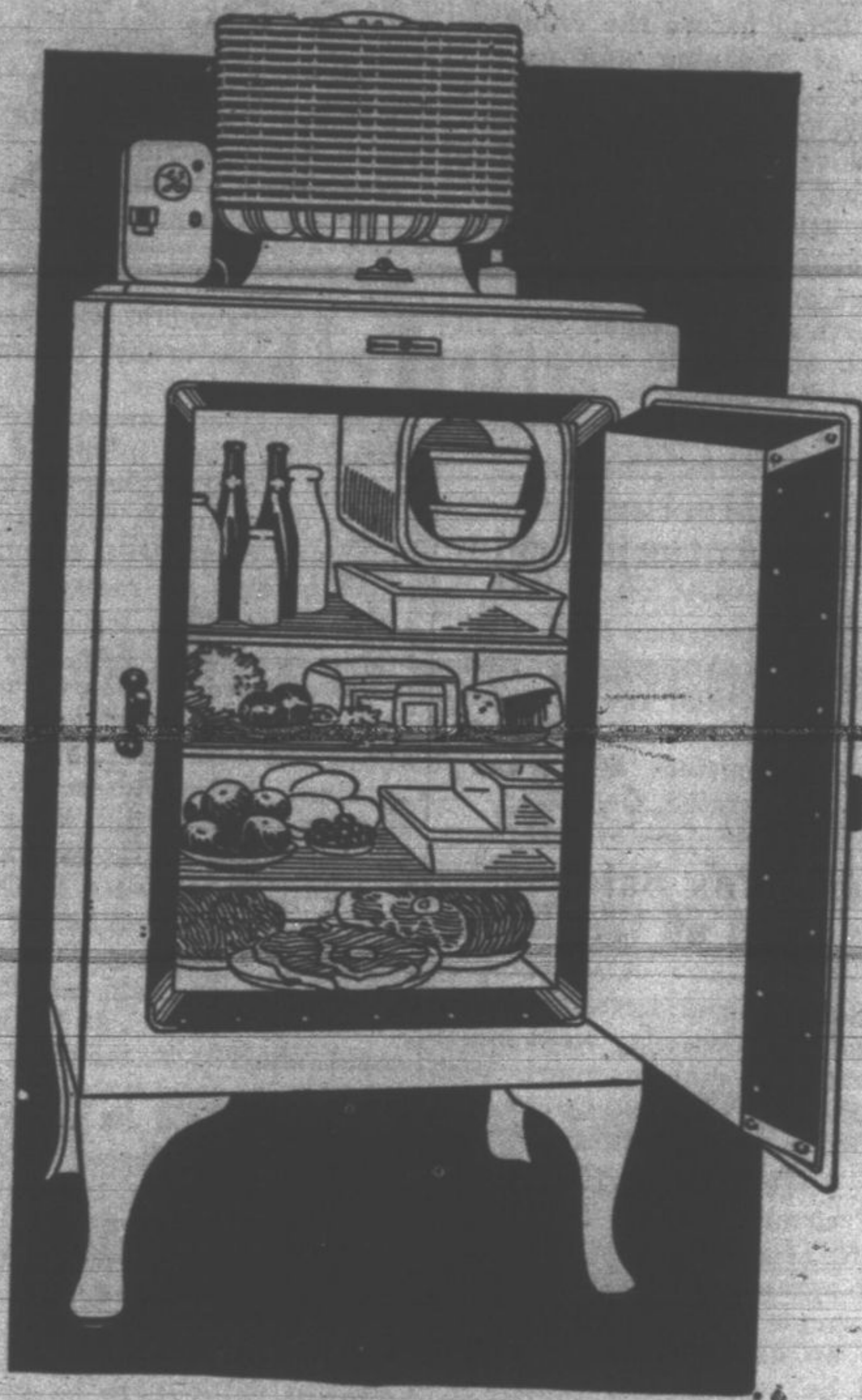
