Lathers in District Get Increase in Pay

An increase in wages of 60 cents a day and a five day week has been granted to lathers of Waukegan and other towns on the north shore in which these workers are affiliated with the Chicago local of that union through agreement signed last week.

The agreement is retroactive to September 1. The new wage schedule of working days will hold good until May 31, 1932.

The most important provision in the agreement, according to labor leaders, is the granting of the shorter work week to another of the building trades.
