AUTO LICENSE FEES USED ON HIGHWAYS

Percentage of Funds Raised
by This Means and Gas
Tax; Build Roads

Approximately 67 per cent of the funds received from state registration fees and gasoline taxes throughout the nation in 1928 was expended for state highways, the balance being spent for administration costs, local roads, retirement of bonds and miscellaneous purposes, according to Charles M. Hayes, president of the Chicago Motor club.

That percentage, Mr. Hayes declared, is based on the fact that the receipts for registration fees and gas taxes last year amounted to \$627,863,867, while \$409,926,863 was expended for state highways. The total receipts from registration fees in the various states in 1928 amounted to \$322,630,025. The disposition of these funds was made as follows:

The total receipts from gasoline taxes in the various states in 1928 amounted to \$305,233,842. The disposition of these funds was made as follows:

Picture for Children at the Field Museum

Some of the sea's greatest thrills will be brought vividly before Chicago children in the moving picture, "The International Ice Patrol" featured on the program to be given Saturday morning, October 5, at Field Museum of Natural History. This is the first of the fall series of James Nelson and Anna Louise Raymond Fund entertainments for children. Stephen C. Sims, director of the museum, invites children from all parts of Chicago and suburbs to attend. Admission is free.

The program will be presented twice, once at 10 a. m., and again at 11 a. m., in the James Simpson theatre of the museum. Three other pictures will be shown tomorrow: "Sea Birds," "Seals," and "Undersea Life of the North Atlantic."

Other children's entertainments provided by the Raymond endowment will be given on the nine following Saturdays in October, November and December. Children may come alone or accompanied by parents or other adults. In many cases groups are formed at schools, playgrounds, and other centers.
