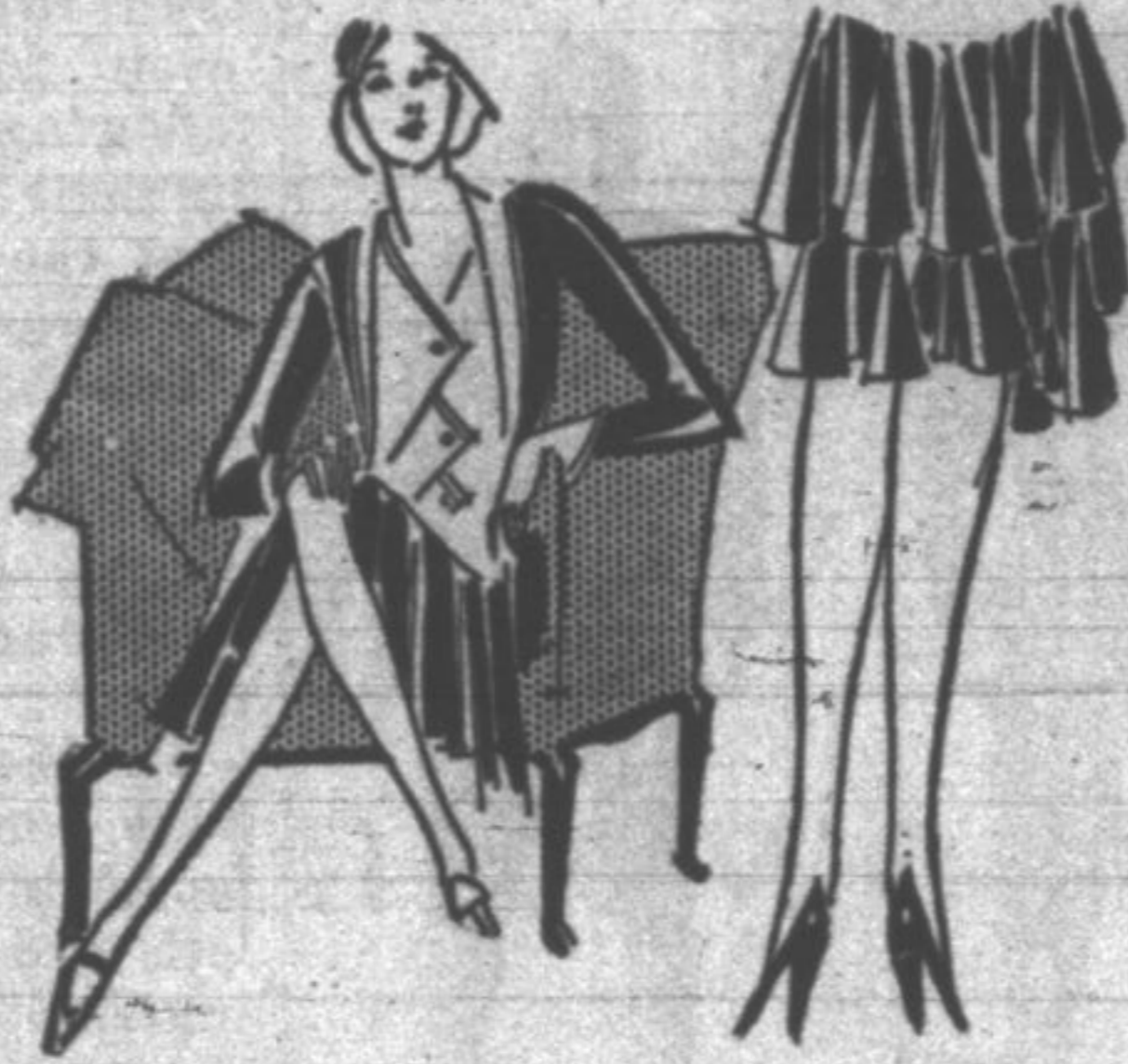

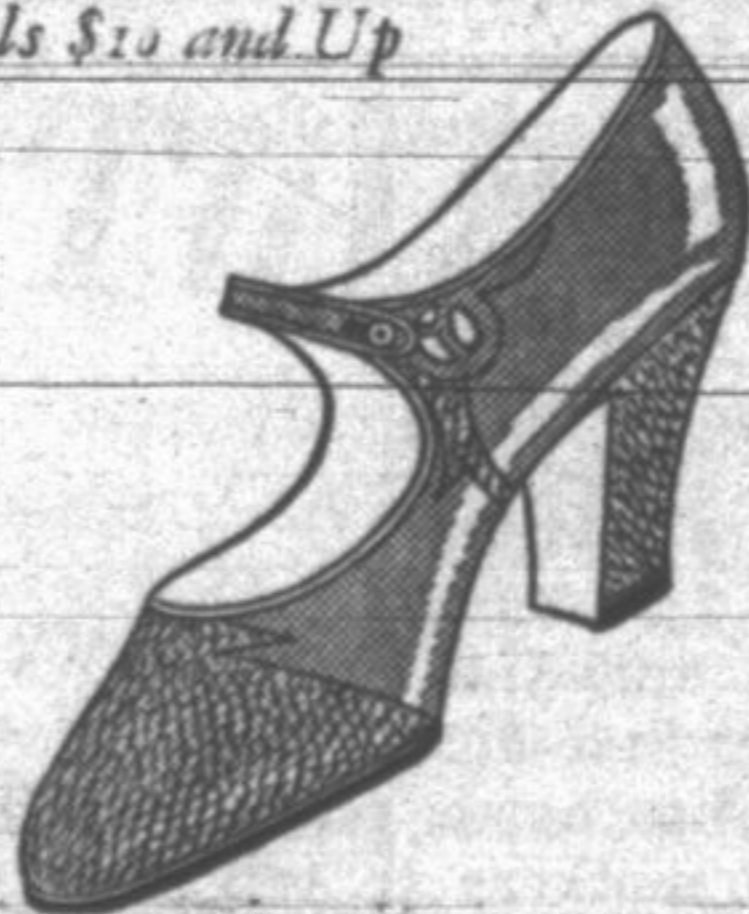

committee expects to devote a considerable part of its work is a survey of art in American industry, particularly as applied to the production of articles for household use and decoration. It is not intended that the survey will be restricted to the handicraft art, but will treat rather more of art as applied to industrial products. It is expected that the results of this survey will be published in some modest form and will supply to the members of the Ravinia Woman's club and others a practical but interesting catalogue of articles for the home, that are distinguished in their artistic merit and are also priced within the reach of all. The members of this committee have felt, and believe others feel, the need for some ready access to the results of the great strides now being made in industry in the production of household articles of unusual artistic quality. It is, of course, not expected that anything more than a start can be made by the committee along this line but it is hoped that the result of the project will be interesting and profitable.

### Federal Building for Waukegan Next Year? Declares Diet Expert

Actual work of erecting the proposed \$335,000 federal building in Waukegan will be started next year if the plans of the treasury department materialize according to Postmaster Mancel Talcott, who recently had a conference with district post-office officials and attaches of the United States district attorneys of offices in Chicago relative to the matter.

Indications are that the condemnation proceedings started by the government to obtain possession of the tract of land on the northeast corner of Madison and Utica streets as the site of the proposed building will be completed before the end of this year which will give the treasury department ample time to prepare its plans and specifications for the building and award the contract on the structure.
