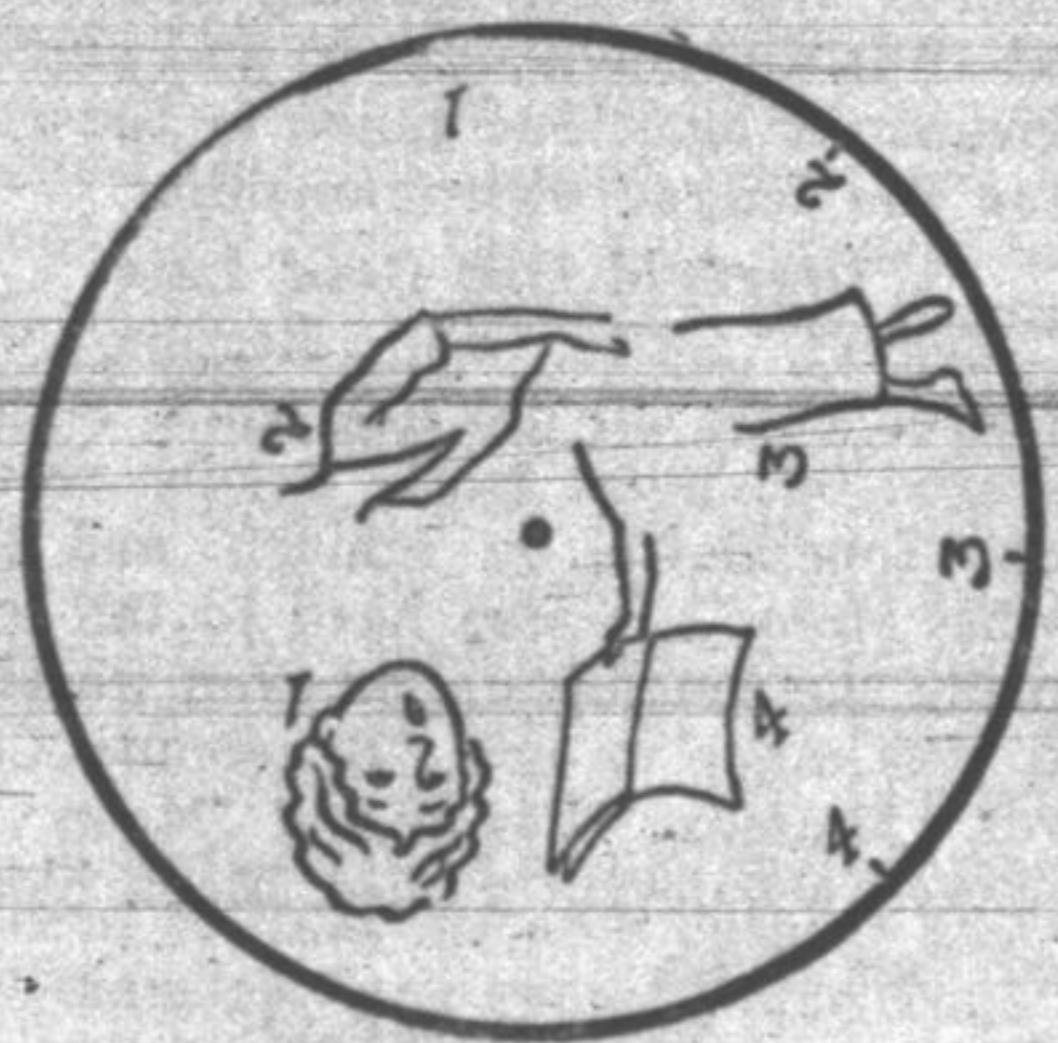

**Dr. Vincent Speaks
at Open Air School**

On Friday, Oct. 25, at the Open Air Nursery school, on Edgecliffe drive, Dr. E. Lee Vincent, consulting psychologist of the Merrill Palmer Nursery school in Detroit, Mich., gave a most instructive and constructive talk on the pre-school child and his problems.

Dr. Vincent's attractive personality, sane views, and fund of experience gave to her talk a convincing sincerity that captivated her audience, composed of teachers and mothers of small children.

In an informal manner, Dr. Vincent traced the growth of the Nursery school idea in its response to the changing conditions of home life in the majority of present day American homes. She emphasized the fact that under ideal conditions the home and the mother were the best caretakers of the child between the ages of two and five, but regretted the obvious fact that such ideal conditions seldom obtain nowadays.

Hence the development of the Pre-Kindergarten school to meet the needs of the youngster who must during these years develop the physical, mental and social habits which are to give him the best means of meeting life. Under trained (and Dr. Vincent stressed the point of the necessity of trained teachers) directors, in a group, it was comparatively simple to develop these habits.

Dr. Vincent made the pleasing statement that Miss Levy, head of the Open Air Nursery school, was one of the outstanding graduates of the Merrill Palmer school, because she has, under the difficulties of a comparatively new movement, successfully organized a group of children, and in a splendid way is carrying out the ideals of that pioneer institution in the training of pre-school children.

A delightful social hour followed Dr. Vincent's talk, in which she gave fruitful advice to those present who wished help on individual problems of their children.

**Suggests Credit Plan
for State Prisoners**

Director Rodney Brandon of the state department of public welfare in conference with the state board of pardons and paroles, has suggested that there be established a system of awards by which first term paroles may earn their discharge from surveillance in a period of two years, with a three-year basis for those who may lapse but whose conduct may entitle them to discharge in this period.

The present basis is five years. It was the director's idea that the plan should provide a comprehensive list of merits, giving credit not only for observance of the law and the rules under which the prisoner is expected to live while on parole, but for improvement in his manner of living, his industry and his mental development.
