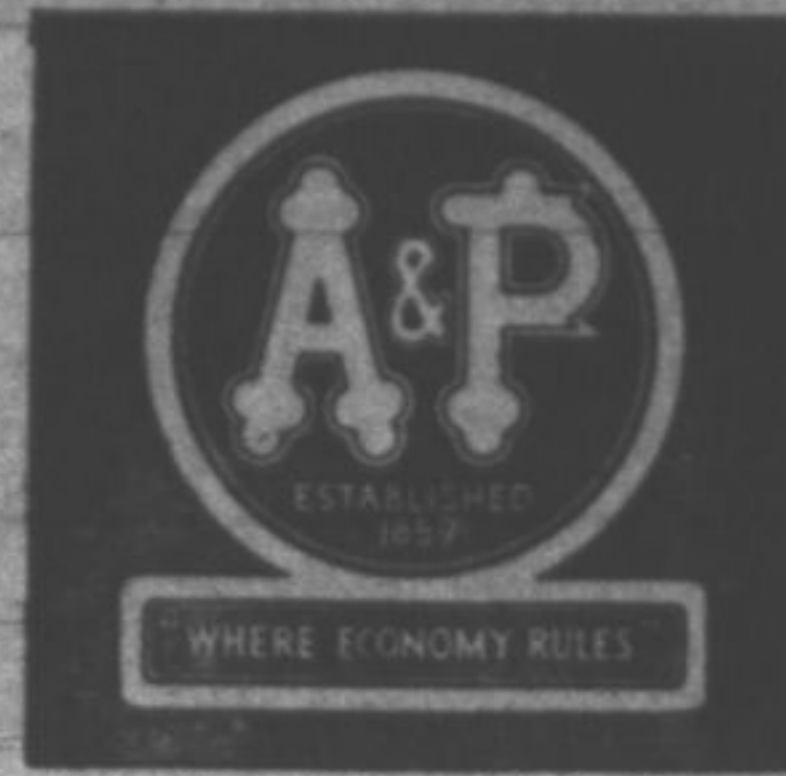

## Mihan Pleads Guilty; Is Sentenced to Prison

Albert Mihan, 53, of 2138 Grand avenue, North Chicago, last week pleaded guilty to a charge of manslaughter before Circuit Judge Clarence C. Edwards and was sentenced from one to fourteen years in state penitentiary at Joliet.

Mihan was charged with the murder of Arthur Jadrich, 22, a North Chicagoan who had visited him the night of the shooting.

The mittimus was effective at the end of five days at which time Mihan was to be removed to the penitentiary.
