

## DEERFIELDS LOSES TO NEW TRIER

### New Trier Victory Surprises Fans; Heavy Line Stops Deerfield Line Plunges

By the close score of 13 to 6, the green and grey-clad warriors of New Trier, defeated Deerfield-Shields last Saturday on the winners' field.

New Trier swept our team off their feet the first half, scoring thirteen points to our six. In the last half of the game, the boys of New Trier put up wonderful defense, which held the powerful Deerfield eleven in check.

Deerfield looked like the better

team, and was faster but lacked the scoring punch. New Trier's heavy line, continuously stopped Deerfield's line plunges.

The teams were well matched and the game was not won until the final whistle had blown.

Because there were so many good runs and tackles, the heroes are hard to select. Melvin "Bud" Moon played a good steady game at right tackle, while Berube, our right end, broke through New Trier's line repeatedly and threw the runner for great losses. O'Connor and Captain Seyfarth made some good gains. Rogan made two good runs, but was stopped several times by the New Trier line.

#### First Quarter

New Trier kicked to Deerfield's 20-yard line, and O'Connor returned it

30 yards to the 50-yard marker. On three line plunges, a first down. Seyfarth circled New Trier's end for another first down. On the next three downs, we failed to gain. Seyfarth kicked to New Trier's 5-yard line. New Trier found our line hard to gain through, and was forced to kick. O'Connor returned the punt five yards to the 30-yard line.

#### New Trier Recovers Fumble

Deerfield fumbled on their 32-yard line and a New Trier man recovered it. Hicks went through tackle for 12 yards to the 20-yard line. Another ten yards through the line and an end run, put the ball over for a touchdown. Thompson plunged over for the extra point.

New Trier kicked to Deerfield's 20-yard line and Seyfarth returned it 15

yards. A pass, O'Connor to Seyfarth was good for 25 yards, which placed the ball on New Trier's 40-yard line. Seyfarth made 10 yards around left end.

#### New Trier's Line Holds

On three plays, Deerfield failed to gain. A pass, O'Connor to Snite failed and the ball went to New Trier on their own 30-yard line.

#### New Trier Starts March

At this point of the game New Trier started a grand march down the field. Eaton, New Trier's right half, found a hole in the line and went through for 20 yards. Captain Hicks of New Trier made a great run down the field, good for 44 yards, which placed the ball on the 6-yard line. On the next play, Thompson the full-back, plunged over for New Trier's second touchdown.

#### Deerfield Scores

New Trier kicked to Deerfield's 30-yard line and O'Connor returned it 10 yards. Rogan made 20 yards around left end. A pass O'Connor to Berube was good for 9 yards, which put the ball on New Trier's 35-yard line. Seyfarth reeled off 25 yards around right end. Rogan made 7 through tackle. On the next play Seyfarth took the ball over for Deerfield's only score of the game. The score was at that time 13 to 6 in favor of New Trier.

Deerfield kicked to New Trier's 37-yard line. Seyfarth intercepted a pass on New Trier's 42-yard line. Seyfarth made twelve around left end and reached New Trier's 27-yard line. Deerfield lost the ball on downs as the half ended.

#### Third Quarter

Deerfield kicked to New Trier's 40-yard line. Eaton went around end for 10 yards. New Trier then kicked to Deerfield's 30-yard line. Our team failed to gain and Seyfarth kicked to New Trier's 3-yard line. The down shore boys made two first downs in succession, which put the ball on the 33-yard line as the third period ended.

#### Fourth Quarter

The last period saw Deerfield fighting harder than ever before. New Trier kept the ball in Deerfield territory by good punting.

New Trier kicked to Deerfield's 30-yard line, and O'Connor returned it 10 yards. Maloney hit right tackle for 10 more yards.

Rogan replaced Maloney at right half.

In the last few minutes neither team could gain through the line. Seyfarth kept the ball in New Trier's territory by some very good punting.

The game ended with New Trier in possession of the ball on Deerfield's 15-yard line.

Our team put up a game fight but was out-classed the first half in offense and could not gain the last half, because of New Trier's defense which was very good.

The final score stood 13 to 6.
