**Varied Uses of Radio in United States are Described; Is Big Aid**

Uncle Sam has even his cousin, John Bull, beaten when it comes to the use of radio. Radio performs valuable service in virtually every branch of the government. The President broadcasts his important speeches and even such governmental minions as lighthouse keepers find radio an aid in whiling away the hours at their lonely posts.

Thousands of words are sent daily over the army and navy networks. Messages reach to fleets far at sea. They speed from Arlington's giant towers on the Potomac to Frisco and on across the Pacific to Cavite.

**Aid to Farmers**  
 Millions of farmers listen in daily on crop, market and homemaking broadcasts from the Agricultural department. Invaluable navigation information is furnished mariners along the seacoasts and on the Great Lakes from the 40 stations maintained for this purpose.

Twice daily coded weather reports from all parts of the continent go forth from San Francisco and Washington. These benefit the aviator.

The coast guard is aided by radio in its warfare against the rum runner and is also brought to the rescue of ships in distress. The hydrographic office utilizes the air to inform mariners of sea hazards and in tracing derelicts.

**Other Uses**  
 Radio is employed by the geodetic survey in measuring ocean depths and exploring the bottom of the sea. It is used by the public health service and radio links the department of commerce with its trade envoys in the far off zones of Africa, China and India.

The bureau of standards is now using radio devices to make flying safer and to improve the apparatus bringing us entertainment and information.

**Reindeer Meat in Cans for Table Use**

Santa Claus' reindeers used to come around but once a year, but they can now be found on the pantry shelves of many kitchens every day in the year. The reason for this is, says Farm & Fireside, that enterprising packers have found reindeer meat in excellent demand.

Reindeer meat is packed in Alaska, well cooked, sliced and put up in its own gravy so that the house-wife has only to heat the can. The price is remarkably low as compared with most meats.

The canned reindeer is only one of the many advances that have been made in meat packing. Whole hams are available in tins as are whole chickens. Long Island duck with mushroom sauce also comes in cans, as does chop suey, Welsh rarebit, chicken a la king and other foods that formerly had to be prepared fresh for every occasion.

Improved packing methods have taken anchovies and caviar out of the ranks of luxuries and they may now be found in five and ten cent stores, according to the article.
