Two Nights Before Christmas

"Twas two nights before Christmas, in 1823, that Santa Claus—the real Santa Claus of the rosy cheeks, cherry nose and droll, bow-like mouth—first guided his eight reindeer to a perfect landing on American snow. Foe it was on this date that the troy sentinel contained an anonymous balled entitled "A visit from St. Nicholas, written the previous year but not printed until this time. In a wise and charming book, "Forgotten Books of the American Nursery," Miss Rosalie V. Halsey observes that the publication of this poem by Clement Clarke Moore "marks the appearance of a truly original story of the American nursery." In the Visit from St. Nicholas" Mr. Moore not only introduced Santa Claus to the young folk of the various states, but gave to them their first story of any lasting merit whatever." Written at a period of moral tales whose purpose was not to amuse children but to harrow their conscience, the poem is a pioneer effort in its "appeal to one of the child's dearest possessions—his imagination."

Holiday Hours

First American Bible

Bible, which is a copy of the Bible translated into the Indian language of John Eliot and printed at Cambridge in New England in the year 1663.
