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PLAN TWO DRIVERS IN EACH RACING CAR

Change in Rules for Big Indianapolis Speedway Event Next Year

Changes in rules for the 500-mile race at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway next May have caused a general revival in the sport that each year draws the largest crowd of spectators in America, says a report from Indianapolis.

With two men riding each car — instead of one; with an elasticity of requirements which will bring a wide variety of shapes, sizes and models to the starting line, more cars already are being built for the race than can be permitted to start.

The speedway management is responsible for the statement that no less than fifty race enthusiasts have announced that they have cars under construction for next May's classic.

May Be 100 Cars

Add to this the large number of hopefuls who are toiling midnight hours in backyard garages, the dyed-in-the-wool race generals who have been building cars for many years and the unprecedented entry list of foreigners who will be attracted here and there is ground for belief that there will be approximately 100 cars nominated for the 18th Annual 500-mile drive next May.

Only 40 cars are permitted to start the 500-mile race, a car for each 330 feet of the two and one-half mile brick and concrete oval, according to the rules of the American Automobile association, the governing body of the speed sport under which the Indianapolis race is conducted.

This means that the Indianapolis plant will be infested with embryo speed champions from the first day of spring until the day of the race, hopeful engineers who will be concocting a diversified mass of mechanical contrivances designed to break all existing records.

Mechanical Changes

That more radical mechanical elements will come into use during the coming race than have made their appearance in the past 10 years, is the belief of engineers who have been in close touch with the preparations which are under way for the coming race.

It is one event in which an unknown barn built speed creation may take the measure of the most astute manufacturing organization. According to the specifications there could readily be 40 entirely different types of cars start the race.
