**Dr. Obermeyer Engaged to Lecture January 22**

"The gift of genius added to profound scholarship illumines all he touches," is the comment of Bishop Frederick James of London on Dr. Obermeyer, who has been engaged by the North Shore Art league to deliver his lecture, "Art of Life and Approach to Modern Aesthetics," Jan. 22 at 8:15 p.m. at Matz hall, Community house, Winnetka. The Art league feels particularly fortunate in procuring this gifted and inspiring speaker. This is one of the several lectures which is exactly fitted for the league's audiences. The interest in Aesthetics has never been so widespread as today and the subject is slowly beginning to assume a definite shape. Modern philosophy and psychology has done much to clarify it, and has pointed the way to where solutions of its problems may most probably be found.

And few problems are more fascinating.  
Dr. Obermeyer, while still a young man has distinguished himself in England for his very brilliant and entirely original lectures on "Literature and Aesthetics."

He has done a great deal of private studying and took his P.H. D. at London university. He had a professorship in the University of South Africa for a few years; resigning to enter the lecture field.  
His success as a lecturer was instantaneous.
