they had visited an invalid sister of Mrs. Goebel. The car was being driven by Charles Feldman, husband of the granddaughter.

Skids on Pavement

As they neared the Deerfield Lutheran church, about a block south of the junction of the Waukegan road with Route 22, Feldman turned the machine out of the line of traffic to pass another machine. He was swinging back into the line at a fast rate of speed when the rear wheels of the machine skidded and the car slid off the pavement.

The car swung about and the rear end crashed against the tree. Mr. and Mrs. Goebel and Mrs. Lawley who were seated in the rear seat received the full force of the collision.

MacLaughlin Aids

Percy MacLaughlin, chief of police of Deerfield, arrived at the scene of the accident a short time after it occurred and with the assistance of spectators removed the injured from the wreck and into the home of Rev. F. G. Piepenbrok, pastor of the Deerfield Lutheran church, who resided nearby.

The injured were given first aid treatment at the home of the pastor, after which Mr. and Mrs. Goebel and Mrs. Lawley were removed to the Highland Park hospital. Mrs. Law-

ley, was later removed to her home in Chicago.

Hold Inquest Monday

Dr. J. L. Taylor, county coroner, at once started an investigation into the accident. An inquest was held Monday morning at the Kelly Funeral home, where the bodies of the two aged victims were held pending their removal to Chicago that afternoon for burial. The coroner's jury after hearing the testimony held that the deaths of the two were due to an accident.
