Increased Equipment Two instead of one automatic rifles per squad in rifle companies.

Addition of one machine gun platoon, two .37 men, cannon and two .74 mm. mortars to the headquarters

The effect of these changes is to increase battalion strength by 326 to 1,178 men and to increase five power by improvement of weapons. Meantime experiments continue on a semiautomatic rifle to supplant the rifle used during the World war.
