BRIEF NEWS ITEMS FROM LAKE COUNTY

Interesting Happenings About This Part of North Shore; County Seat

Blood poisoning arising from a small scratch on the thumb of her right hand, resulted fatally for Mrs. Alfred Ashton, 45 years old, of 2705 Elm avenue, Zion, in the St. Therese hospital in Waukegan last week.

Harold Nuttall, of Waukegan last week received an appointment from Gov. Louis L. Emmerson as superintendent of maintenance for the first district that comprises the counties of northeastern Illinois.

Arthur Reid, 41, boxcar bandit sentenced to serve from one year to life in Joliet penitentiary for attempting to burglarize freight cars at Lake Villa, was taken to Joliet last week under a guard of three deputy sheriffs. He probably will be transferred to the Chester prison later.

Elmer E. Rose, who has owned and operated a farm south of Gurnee in Warren township for nearly 66 years, passed away at the home last week after a long period of ailment. He was 68 years of age.

Charles A. Hummer, village attorney of Lake Bluff, is considering entering the race for state legislature eighth senatorial district, comprising Lake, Boone and McHenry counties, it was reported last week by his friends.

Lee McDonough, state representative and the only Waukegan resident in either house, last week stated that he was making preparations for a campaign for re-election that would be based on his record made in the 56th General Assembly.

John Feldt, who jumped a bond in Waukegan almost five years ago when he was arrested on a charge of wife and child abandonment, last week won his fight in Laramie, Wyo., against being extradited to Illinois for trial on the old charge, according to Sheriff Lawrence Doolittle.

After breaking ice for more than 17 miles in a futile effort to reach their nets, two large fishing tugs of the Smith Fishing company and the Kopplemann Fishing company of Waukegan were forced to return to port one day last week minus both their nets and fish.

Lake Zurich Farmer Found Dead in Field

William Schmidt, 57 year old farmer living near Lake Zurich, died suddenly last week, while loading hay into a wagon on his farm, two miles northwest of Lake Zurich. Schmidt collapsed while working and when a physician arrived at the farm the man was dead.

Schmidt is survived by his wife and several children. He was widely known in the farming community near Lake Zurich. A coroner's jury found death due to heart trouble.
