Largest Lapis-Lazuli Mass in Field Museum

The largest known single mass of lazurite or lapis-lazuli is on exhibition in the department of geology at Field Museum of Natural History. It is about two feet long, more than a foot wide, and about eight inches thick. This block of the beautiful blue stone was found in an ancient Inca grave in Peru, and its shape and surface have been preserved practically as when it came from the hands of the ancient workmen.

Peculiar Habits of Glacial Bears Noted

While its cubs are small, the male glacier bear leaves home and does not associate with his mate and offspring, leaving the family entirely in charge of mother for quite an extended period. A group of mother and three cubs, shown in a reproduction of their natural habitat near Yakutate Bay, Alaska, is on exhibition at Field Museum of Natural History. These small bears are a beautiful bluish-gray in color and are found only in Alaska.

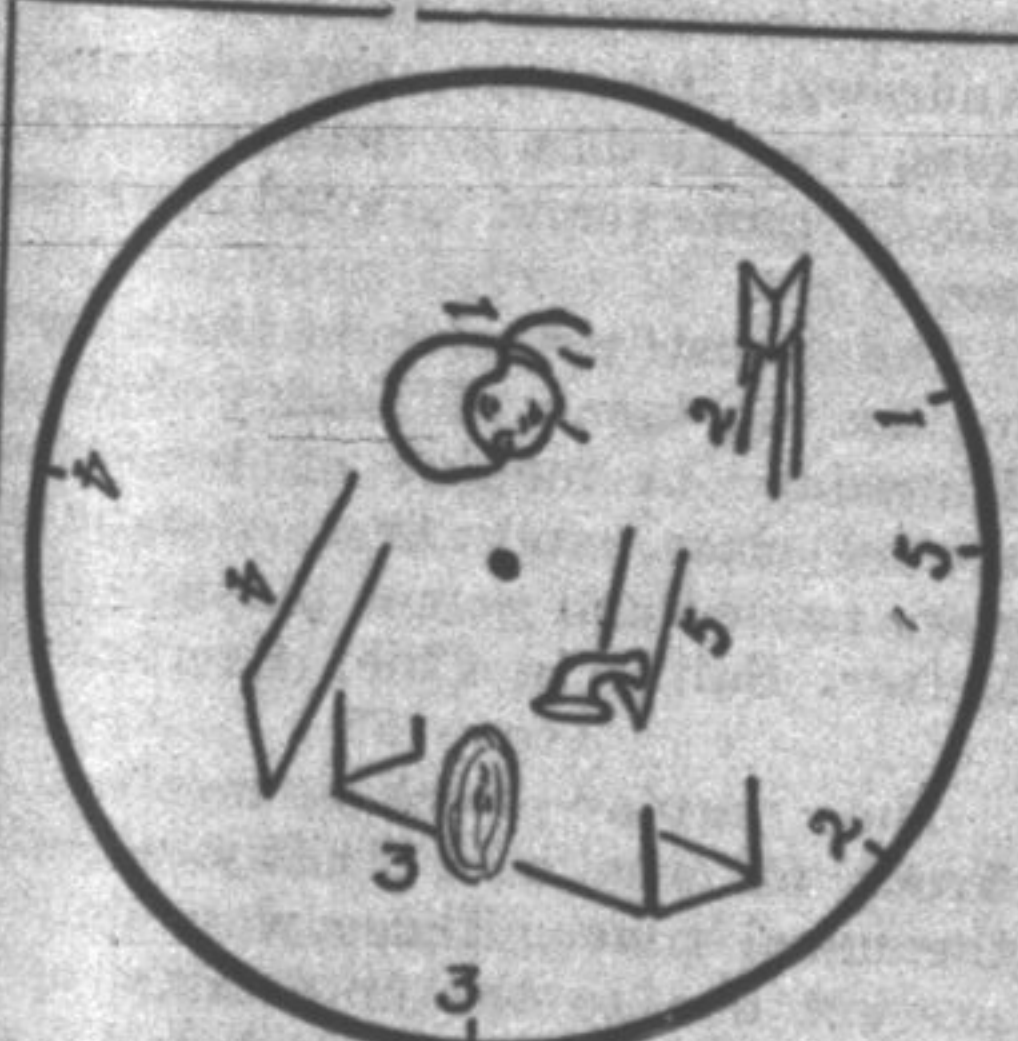
