

### Tax Revision Plan Is Income Tax Is Report

Indications that the tax revision committee of the state senate will recommend provisions that will eliminate or lessen the taxes on real estate and increase those on other tangible property and possibly suggest an income tax, developed at the meeting of the senate committee with representative of taxing bodies in the state at the Hotel LaSalle in Chicago last week, according to Mayor Yager of Waukegan.

Mayor Yager attended the meeting as one of the three representatives of the Illinois Municipal league. Mayor Bartlett of Evanston and Mayor Kelley of Elgin are the other members of the committee.

The fact that but 8 per cent of the population of the state of Illinois pays taxes was brought out at the meeting. The great percentage of taxes collected in the state is derived from real estate.

Charles Rosa, chairman of the Wisconsin Tax commission was the principal speaker at the event.

It was also stated at the meeting that a special session of the legislature may be asked in which the report of the committee will be considered. This would likewise assist Chicago in its present situation.

### Young Antioch Farmers Making Notable Record

Thirty-five members of the Antioch chapter of the Future Farm of America produced \$9,125.93 worth of farm products during 1929 under the

supervision of their instructor while attending the Antioch Township high school. These boys selected eight major projects to work on. Poultry, sheep, dairy, swine, beef cattle, horse, grain and garden projects were selected. Each boy worked on one or more projects and kept an accurate record of all labor and transactions. Only four of the 35 projects were operated at a loss.

The expenses of all the projects totaled \$5,354.78; including labor charges paid to the students themselves, leaving a net profit of \$3,771.15 and a net earning of \$4,194.35 when adding their labor to the net profit.
