

## D. T. H. S. SWIMMERS PLACE AT WAUKEGAN

Phil Anderson and Eddie Loewenstein garnered first in the 100-yard back, and third in the 100-yard breast stroke, respectively at the Waukegan invitational swimming meet held on Saturday, February 22.

Phil won the 100-yard backstroke in 1:31 1/2 without a lot of trouble, but wrenched a muscle in his side before he could enter the 100-yard free

style. The muscle, which he first wrenched last summer while doing a half gainer dive has caused him considerable trouble both in swimming and in tumbling. The accident at Waukegan occurred while Phil was making a turn in the 100-yard backstroke event.

Eddie swam a beautiful race to take a third against some of the best swimmers on the North Shore.

The 200-yard relay was won by Waukegan, with Evanston second, and Kenosha third. The time was 1:48-2.5. In the Medley relay, Oak Park

swam away with first honors. Evanston came in second, and Kenosha, third.

Oak Park won the meet with Evanston runner-up. Deerfield-Shields came in fifth place. Anderson and Loewenstein were the only swimmers entered from Deerfield-Shields.

ment consisting of the acquiring and clearing of a right-of-way and easement for a public street and drainage therefor in Block 23, Highland Park, Lake county, Illinois, and the construction of a reinforced concrete pavement, concrete separate curb and the necessary drainage in the said proposed street, to be constructed in Sheridan road, Central avenue, Laurel avenue, St. Johns avenue, and in the easements and rights-of-way to be acquired."

Commissioner Zimmer moved that an ordinance granting the city of Lake Forest right to construct, repair and maintain underground sewers and outlet sewers in, across and along certain public thoroughfares in the northwest portion of Highland Park be read and placed on file for public inspection.

Approval and acceptance was voted the "Plat of subdivision of Lot 7 in Deere Park subdivision."

On motion \$2,100 was ordered paid out of the street widening bond fund to the contractor on the South Green Bay road paving improvement, in accordance with the estimate approved by the Board of Local Improvements.

A. G. McPherson, Inc. was granted permission to install a flood light on their building at Park and St. Johns avenues, in accordance with their request therefore said work to be done in accordance with the requirements of the building inspector.
