TEN MERMEN WIN 'D'S; SIX SENIORS AND FOUR JUNIORS

Phil Anderson Heads Seniors; Eddie Lowenstein, Second; Reeves Stars for Juniors

Six Deerfield-Shields senior swimmers and four junior men earned their letters this season under the direction of Mr. Kendig, coach. Although the season cannot be termed successful as far as wins and losses go, the squad was larger this year than ever before, with more fellows trying out for the teams. The competition in the Suburban League is the stiffest anywhere in or about Chicago. The senior team ended with a .400 percentage in the league and the juniors with a .200 standing.

Phil Anderson Scores 48½ Points

Phil Anderson led the scoring for the seniors, garnering 48½ points in only four meets. In every event that Phil entered he swam to a first and either relay team he swam in always won. He did not become eligible until the first three meets had taken place.

Eddie Lowenstein came second in the number of points gathered this season. He chalked up 35½ in seven meets. Eddie swam breast stroke all season and never placed lower than second in any event.

Lester Wellman, who swam junior last year, earned his senior letter this season by swimming 19½ points. Les only competed in six meets as he was sick when the second Waukegan meet took place.

Johnny Horn earned his "D" this season, with 16 points to his credit. Steve Hopkins came close behind with 15½ points. Both swam the crawl.

David McCalla, after being sick

last year, came back strong this season and won 15½ points, which is enough to earn a letter. "Dave" swims both the crawl and breast stroke equally well.

Reeves Stars for Juniors

"Kenny" Reeves, a freshman of Mr. Ballard's home room, led the juniors in scoring with 30 points. In the Proviso meet he swam to firsts in the 40-yard and 60-yard crawl, making a total of 10 points in one meet.

Johnny Kraft, after missing his letter by one point last year, came back this year and chalked up 29 markers, almost twice as many points as were needed. Johnny dove to four firsts and three seconds in seven meets.

Warner Turriff and Ben Stein were the only other juniors winning their letters. Warner garnered 17 points, taking firsts in the backstroke in the first two meets.

Seniors who missed a letter by a few points are "Randy" Roberts, and "Rusty" Thomas.

Jeppson of the juniors just missed his "D" by a point.

Place at Suburban Meet

In the Waukegan invitational meet Phil Anderson swam to a first in the backstroke and Eddie Lowenstein to a third in the breast. The two fellows placed in the same order at the final Suburban league meet held at New Trier. Coach Kendig didn't enter anybody in the junior events.
