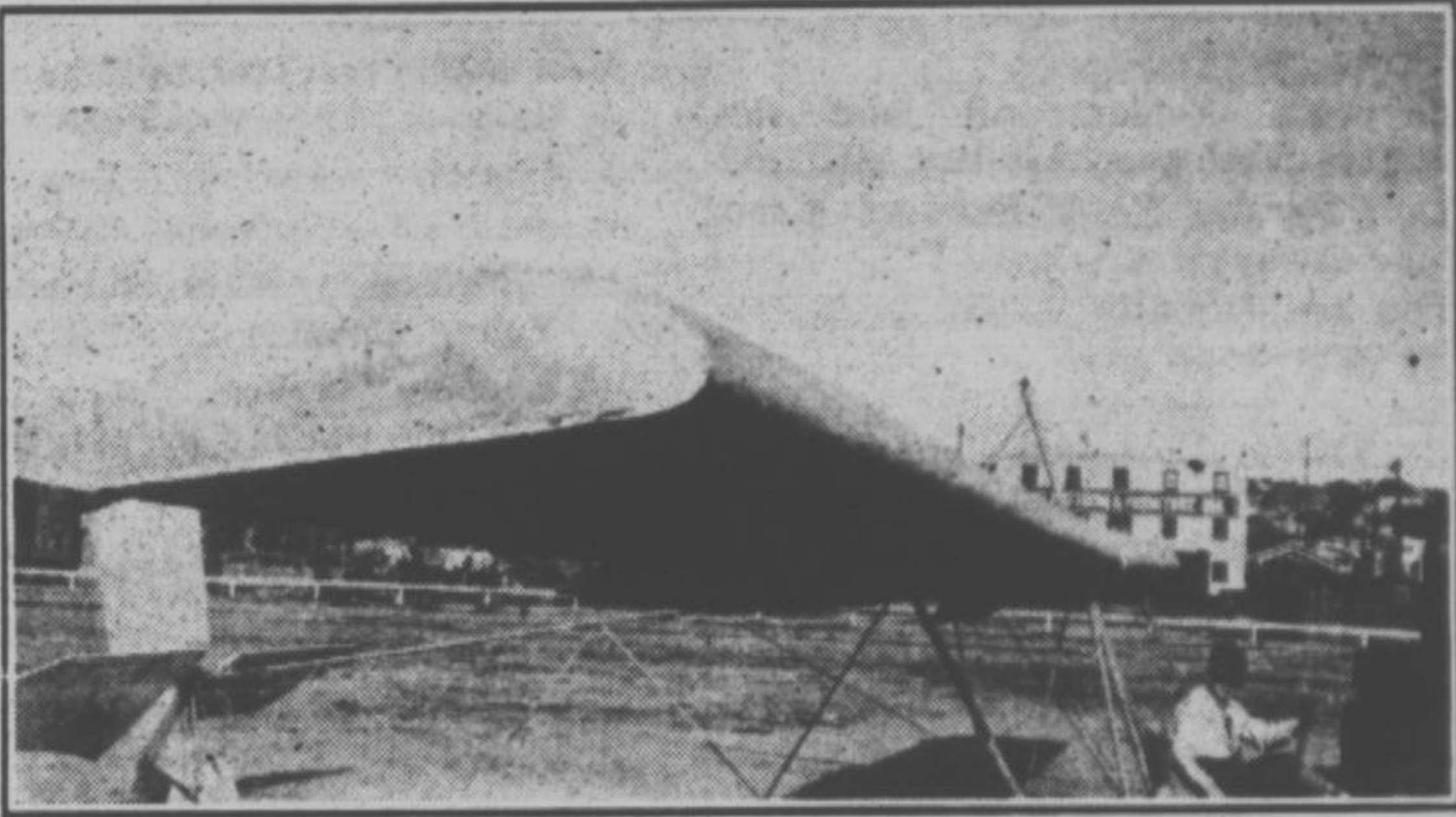


In Lindbergh's Glider

H. P. Members of Women Voters League Plan to Attend Birthday Party

A number of Highland Park members have already planned to attend the League of Women Voters' "birthday party" to be given on March 26. Tables of 10 have been arranged, and tickets may be secured from Mrs. Constant Hopkins, H. P. 80. It is hoped that Highland Park may be represented by a full table, as this celebration should give a broader understanding of the league's achievements, and a new inspiration for the future.

Following is the Cook County League's announcement of the program: In recognition of the tenth anniversary of woman suffrage and the forming of the National League of Women Voters, the Cook County League of Women Voters is arranging

a birthday luncheon to be held at the Palmer House March 26 at 12:15. Similar luncheons are being held all over the country. At 1 o'clock the Cook County league will listen in on a national hook-up which is being broadcast by the National Broadcasting Corporation from New York and Washington. Miss Katherine Ludington of the National board will speak on "Unforeseen in 1920." "The hopes of the Founders" is the subject of Mrs. Carrie Chapman Catt, honorary president of the league, while "The Discoveries of the Members" by Miss Belle Sherwin, president of the National league will close the program which is being carried by KYW.

Miss Julia Lathrop, former president of the Illinois League of Women Voters and former chief of the Children's bureau in Washington, will talk on the "League of the Future" while Mrs. Catherine Waugh McCulloch,

legislative chairman of the Illinois Equal Suffrage association, when suffrage was granted to Illinois women in 1913, will speak on "Our Debt."

Arguments for the passage of the referendum which would permit women to sit on juries in Illinois will be presented in a play "Not Guilty" written by Mrs. Harold Wood and presented by Mrs. Adolph Hartmann, Miss Emily Taft and Mr. Paul Rittenhouse.

Women who were active in the suffrage campaign and those who have since taken an active part in politics will be among the guests of honor.

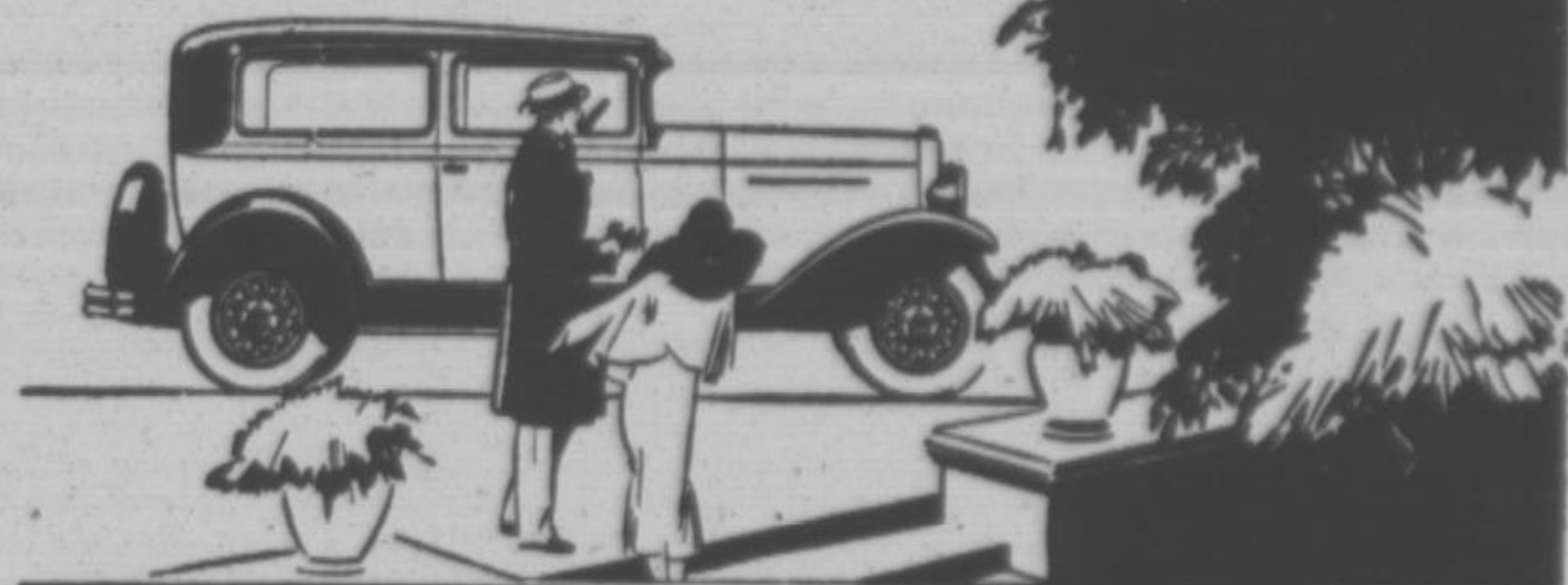
