

Lake County Man's Cow in Milk Record

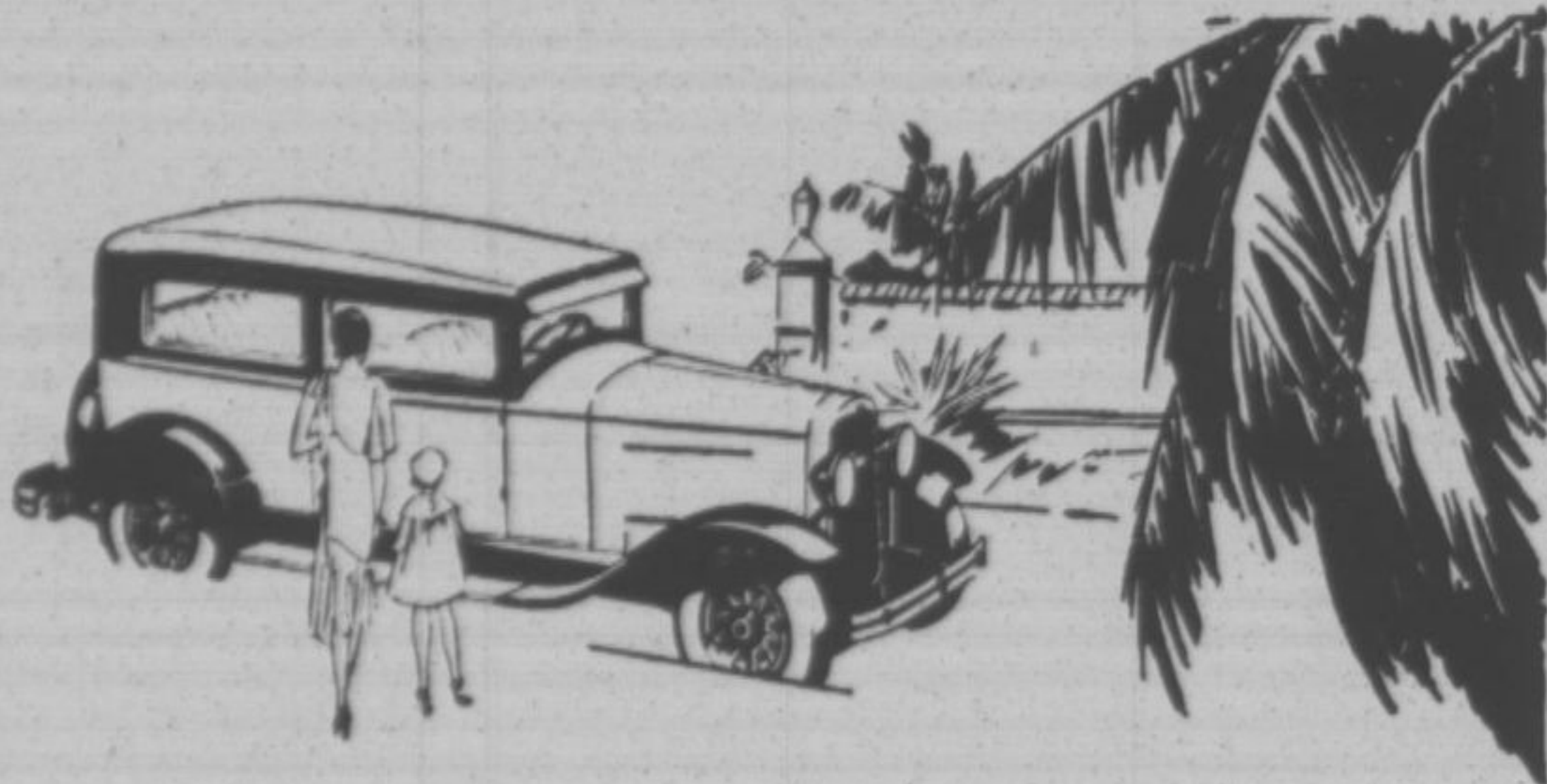
J. L. Mohrmann, a farmer living just west of Waukegan, has won a notable victory with his pure-bred Holstein cows, Lady Spofford Neeltje, over Ruth Hanna McCormick's best cows of the same breed.

Mohrmann's cow gave 21,721 pounds of milk, making 1,033 pounds of butter, in a year's contest. Ellwood & Uelson of DeKalb had a two-year-old

heifer in this contest which gave 18,710 pounds of milk in the year.

Mrs. McCormick's Rock River Farms took the best seven-day record. Star Johanna Roberta is credited with 29.5 pounds of butter and 648 pounds of milk in the single week. Joe Superba of these farms gave 654.7 pounds of milk, but fell a little under the other in butter; making 28 pounds. Other great records were made by Mrs. McCormick's herd.

JUDICIAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER, BELIEF

Gov. Emmerson Unwilling to Call Special for Circuit Judge Is Report

Governor Louis L. Emmerson will not, unless he takes an entirely different attitude than expressed last week, call a special election for the purpose of naming a successor to Circuit Judge Claire C. Edwards, resigned, it was learned last week.

In addition, it was understood that Judge Edwards' resignation would be accepted by April 1 or before that date.

Gov. Emmerson declined to call a special election on the grounds that it would cost close to \$12,000 and such an expenditure would not be essential as long as the district can ballot on the candidates as early as the regular November election.

Shurtleff Calls Lawyers

An effort to adopt a definite policy of procedure for the spring and summer is being made by the Lake County Bar association. Circuit Judge Edward Shurtleff, of Marengo, who is to sit in the Lake county circuit court while the vacancy exists.

Chancery jury trials can be held until May 12, Judge Shurtleff pointed out, and he wanted to learn, he stated, if the attorneys wanted to work as late as July 1 on jury cases. In case trials end at the usual period he does not care to remain in Waukegan to hear occasional pleadings. He would be willing, he declared, to return for

Take Up Subway Plan with State Commission

Headed by R. M. Lobdell, county superintendent of highways, and Mayor Walter L. Atkinson of North Chicago, a delegation went last week to Springfield to discuss with state departmental heads the feasibility of a subway to relieve the congestion now present at the 22 street and Sheridan road crossing in North Chicago.

The crossing has long been known as "death crossing" and scores of accidents, several of which have resulted fatally, have occurred.

The appointment at Springfield was with Hon. H. H. Claveland, director of public works and buildings in Illinois.

It was expected that Mr. Lobdell also would learn what the state of Illinois is planning to do in this county in paving work during the coming summer months.
