## Waukegan Fisherman Fined for Violation

Warning that a strict enforcement of the commercial fishing laws would have to be observed by Waukegan fisherman served rather forcibly last week when Henry Kern, deputy state game warden, arrested Peter Pravanas, of Harbor place on the city dock, on a charge of illegal fishing.

Pravanas, when arraigned before Justice Harry Hoyt, pleaded guilty and was fined \$500 and costs.

The fine was severe because Kern stated that there had been at least four shipments of undersized trout to the Chicago markets. A fine of \$100 was assessed on each charge.
