Mrs. Grace Smith and children of Highwood are out of quarantine with Scarlet Fever.

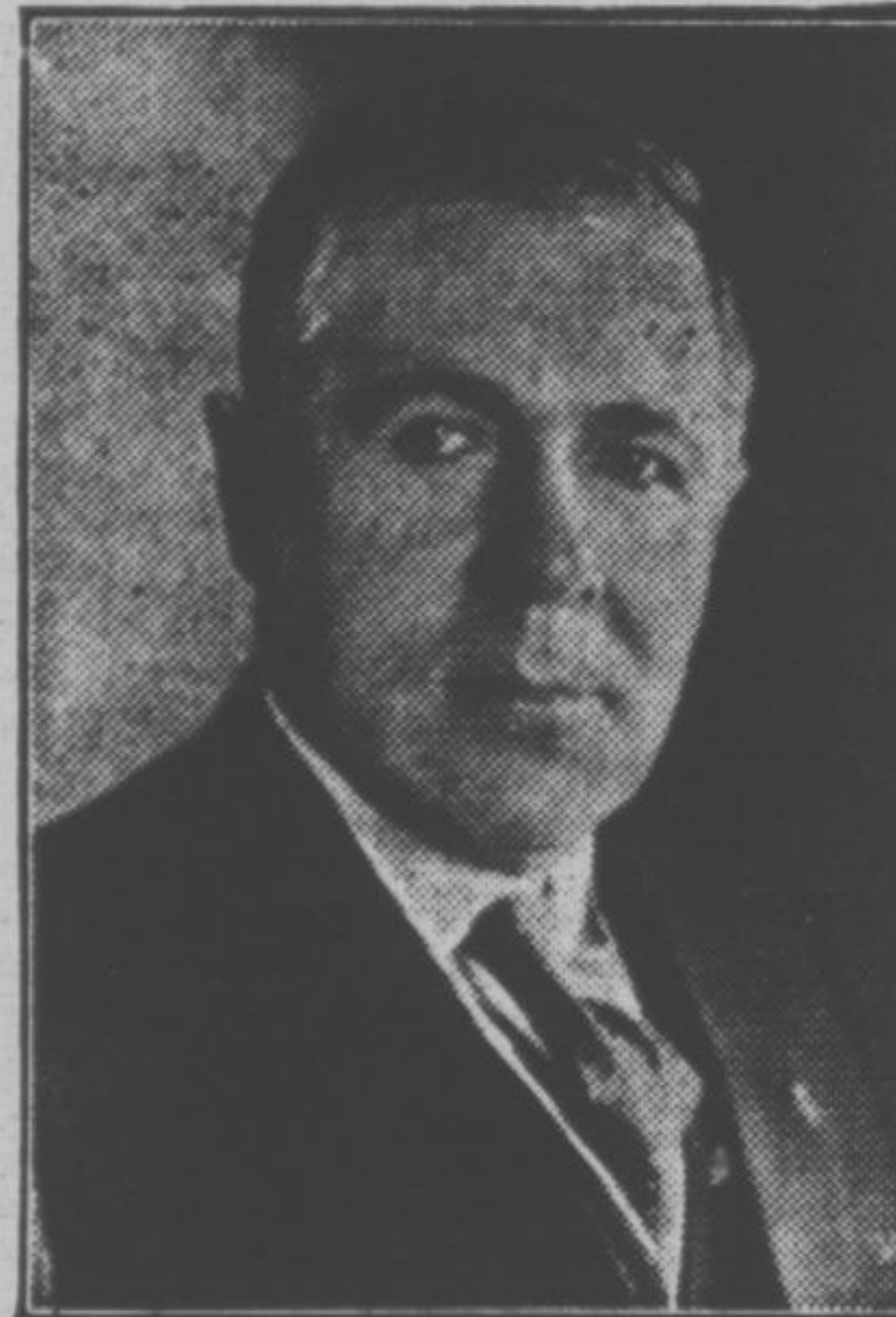
Mr. and Mrs. E. Holmstead and son, Jimmy, of North avenue are visiting this week at the home of John Byers of La Grange, Illinois.
