Fords Offer Variety of Bodies for Family Use

"The Fordor, which comes in two-window and three-window types, possesses a new smartness and a new dignity. The new wide flowing fenders, the improved lines, the cowl finish strip of rustless steel and the flat rustless steel hub caps give it the beauty and charm of the large and expensive car.

To Vote on Addition to High School District

Notices have been issued that at the annual school election on Saturday, April 12, in the Deerfield-Shields high school district a proposition to annex to the district a certain tract comprising the village of Lake Bluff and adjacent territory, described as "all of sections 7, 8, 9, 16, 17, 19, 20 and 21, all in Township 44, north of Range 12 and east of the Third principal meridian in the County of Lake, State of Illinois. At this election also one or more members of the board of education will be elected. Polls will be open from 12 noon to 7 p. m., and the polling places will be in the east building of the high school, Highland Park; in the Oak Terrace school, Highwood; in the city hall, Lake Forest, and in the town hall, Deerfield.
