

**Wieland Dairy Co. Has

The new plant of the Wieland Dairy company, Inc., located at 3014 N. Tripp avenue Chicago, stands today as an embodiment of everything that is most advanced in the handling of milk for the household market, and supplying routes covering the north-west part of the city of Chicago, and west suburbs as far as Oak Park and Berwyn.

Huge plate glass windows lay open to the spectator the most attractive rooms, namely the bottle washing room, the bottle filling room and the pasteurizing room, the latter nearly on a level with the observation room, the former two on the floor below but lying open to the spectators from the observation room. These rooms are not only in-

teresting and instructive to the layman but possess an element of beauty that makes them peculiarly inviting to contemplate.

The washer room is in fact a lofty hall in which the big machines are displayed in the most effective way.

The pasteurizing room is a thing of beauty. The great apparatus stands out shining in the abundant light, and the surface coolers in the privacy of their glass-walled enclosures offer a spectacle that is eminently satisfactory to the observing eye.
