

### Former Resident Is Victim of Heart Attack

The death of Mr. Charles Emmett Sharpless of the Mission Hill Country club of Northbrook, Illinois, occurred suddenly Thursday afternoon, March 27. Death was due to a violent heart attack.

Mr. Sharpless, apparently in the very best of health left his home at The Mission Hill Country club, Thursday afternoon to motor to the village of Northbrook. He was accompanied by his three sons, Donald K., Charles Jr., and Jack Sharpless, and Mr. William Puddy of Lake Forest. Enroute to the village Mr. Sharpless spoke of feeling faint and those with him attempted to revive him by applying

snow to his hands and face, and a few minutes later as he appeared to feel better they continued on their way to the village, where again Mr. Sharpless became very weak and ill. They hastened with him to the nearest doctors office where he was attended by two physicians but all efforts to save him failed and death occurred within a few moments.

Charles Emmett Sharpless was born October 19, 1876—and died in the very prime of his life, age 53 years.

Mr. Sharpless has been employed as manager of the Mission Hill Country club of Northbrook, Illinois, for the past several years and here he and his family made their home. Previous to coming to the Mission Hill club, the Sharpless family had made

their home in Highland Park for many years.

The funeral services took place Sunday afternoon, March 30, at 2 o'clock. The Rev. W. F. Suhr of the Lutheran church of Highland Park officiating. Burial was in the Mooney (Union) cemetery of Highland Park, Illinois.
