Prior to his elevation to the Episcopacy he held the chair of Philosophy and Systematic Theology at the Evangelical Theological seminary, Naperville, Illinois. He has gained the reputation of being a profound thinker and a great preacher.

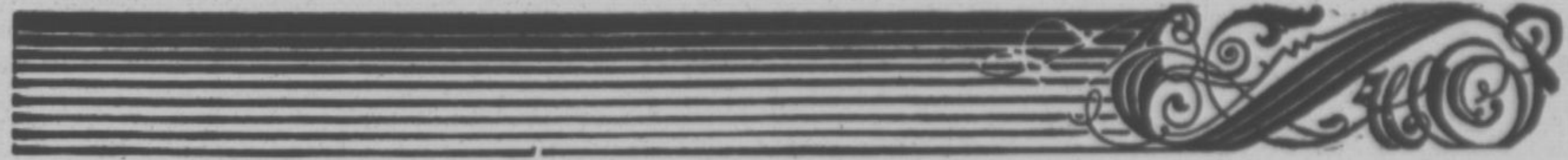
Passover Services at Glencoe Church
