county assessing machinery, an income tax-all these and more were proposed in 1929 and will come back with increased insistence in 1931. The Illinois State Revenue Investigation commission has the opportunity with the help of the legislators to perform a major operation on the state and local government finance systems.

"Revision of election laws is also an opportunity for the next legislature. The State Commission on Revision of Election laws has many proposals before it. Shall a state supervised system of elections be instituted with permanent personal registration for all voters? Shall the hallot be changed to the office group form? Can it be shortened?

"A better day for Illinois children is promised through the work of the State Child Welfare Commission. Studies are now being made on child health, child labor, dependency, juvenile delinquency. Has not the time come to give counties permission to have health departments?

"Another increase in the state school distributive fund is to be asked in order that children in rich and poor school districts may have a more equal chance. How can Illinois join the movement for consolidating rural school districts to get better school administration, supervision and teaching? This is a knotty legal

problem which has kept Ililnois behind in school district consolidation.

"One day's rest in seven and a shortened work day for women in industry,-is the state now ready to give these protections to its workers?

"Home rule for Illinois cities, reasonable and adequate powers of local government, are needed to enable Illinois cities to cope with their growing problems. The Legislature for example, has refused to give any city over 5000 the right to have its citizens adopt a city manager charter.

"Legislators will have the opportunity both in handling requests from their constituents and in legislation, to uphold the merit system, thereby aiding the governor in reestablishing it throughout the State's Civil Ser-

"What is the next move in caring for the insane? Must we still further enlarge our building program?

"By eleven votes the Motor Driver's License bill lost in the last session. Will the incoming legislators be sufficiently aware of the mounting roll of deaths and accidents so that they will be ready to try this tested method of ruling the irresponsible driver from the roads?"
