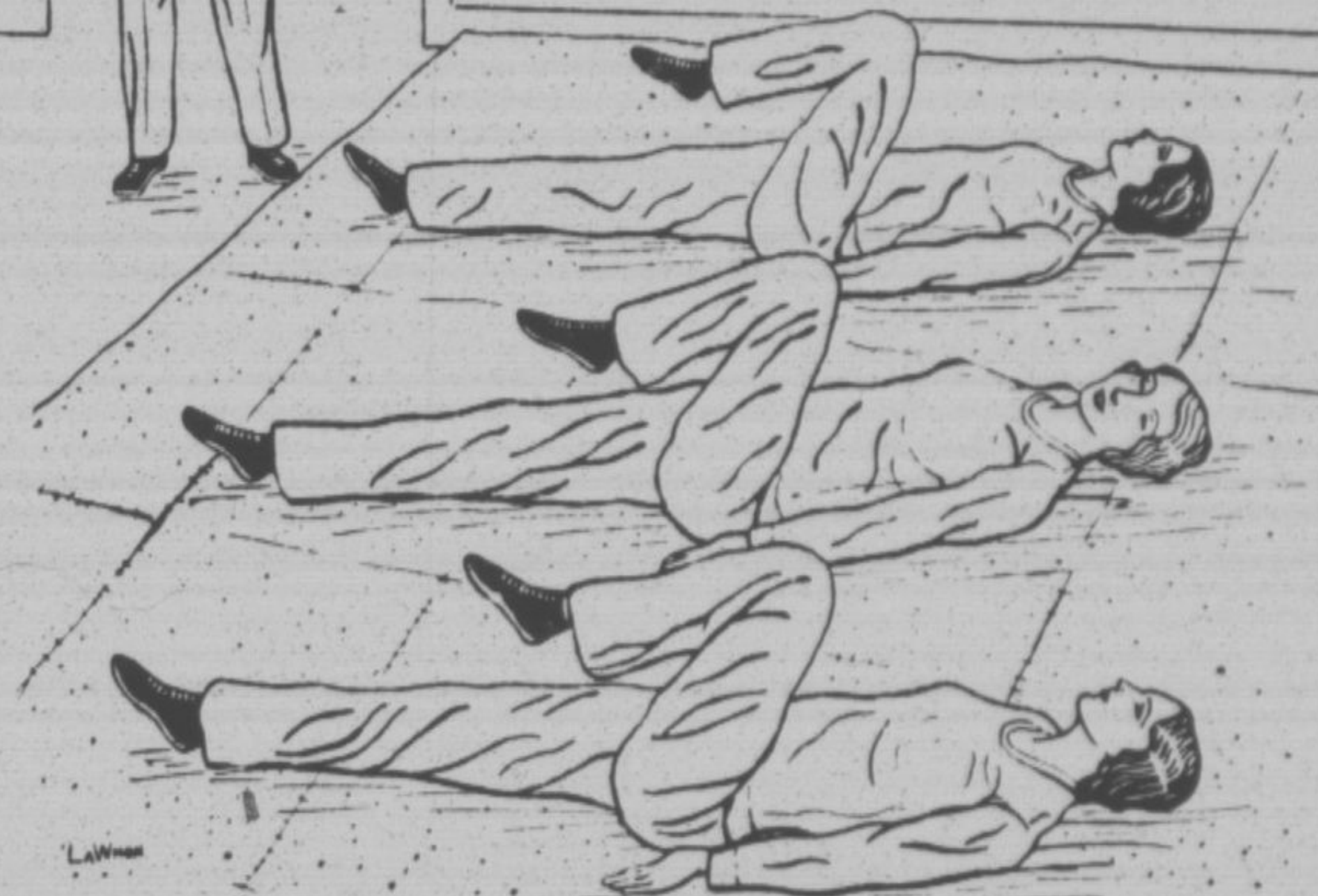

Second Road Letting by State on May 7th; Bridges in Lake Co.

The second road letting of the 1930 construction season will be held at Springfield, on May 7, when bids will be received for 155.88 miles of new concrete paving, 10.92 miles of grading, several miles of widening, and the erection of viaducts and bridges, including the Hardin bridge over the Illinois river.

The estimated cost of the work proposed in the letting totals \$6,250,000 which, with the work scheduled in the first letting, on April 11, brings the grand total of the work already announced for this year to more than \$10,000,000.

A total of 1,646 miles of widening, and the construction of a viaduct at the B. & O. C. T. tracks in McCook are scheduled for the metropolitan area. In addition, the schedule also includes the construction of bridges from the Cook-Lake county line to Half Day. More widening projects undoubtedly will be included in future lettings.

Modern Basement Has Boiler with Colorful Jacket; Description

The boiler in the modern basement is dressed up. It is today as much a piece of furniture as the davenport and the piano in the upstairs living room.

It is enclosed in a brilliantly colored jacket. It is perfectly at home

This type of boiler is fast replacing its unattractive predecessor, according to the Plumbing and Heating Industries bureau, which has recently completed a study of changing styles in boilers.

The modern home owner, the bureau finds, wants his basement to be attractive in appearance. When he plans his heating equipment, he insists on having a jacketed boiler.

The "jacket" is bolted to the boiler. As it is lined with asbestos, it furnishes insulation, which checks heat losses through the sides and in this way reduces fuel bills.

Former Lake County Trainer Dies in West

Harry Putnam, 55, for many years a resident of Libertyville, and widely known throughout the county, died recently at his home in Teckla, Wyoming it was learned today. Putnam moved from Libertyville to Teckla in 1920.

Well known in turf circles, Putnam was the trainer of the famous "Peter Manning," world's champion trotter, owned by William M. Wright, president of the Calumet Baking Powder company. Many other noted racing horses had been placed under his care at various times.

Putnam had been suffering from chronic kidney trouble.

He is survived by two daughters and three sons all of Teckla, Wyo.
